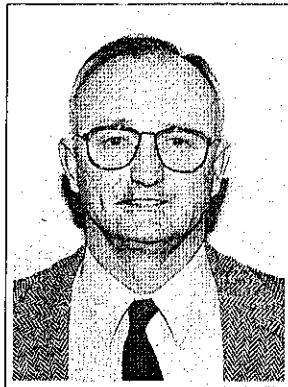

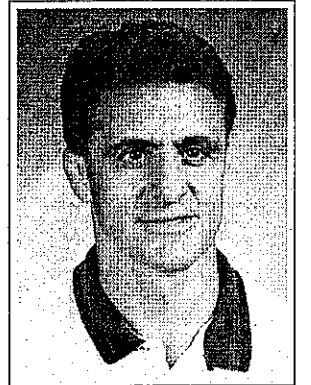


MEET THE GOODRICH COACHES

LARRY MARCHIONDA, Head Coach

Larry attended Penn Yan Academy in Penn Yan, New York, where he accumulated a 97-4 high school record. His senior year in high school Larry was unbeaten and pinned every opponent. He attended Winona State University where he earned his Bachelor and Master of Science Degree. He was a 1968 Olympic Regional Champion and a finalist in the 1968 Olympic Trials at Ames, Iowa. He has won several Wisconsin State AAU and USA Freestyle and Greco Roman Championships.

Larry is beginning his 33rd year as a head wrestling coach, 31st for the Cardinals. He has compiled a dual meet record of 345-59; 323-59 for Fondy and 22-0 at Cochrane-Fountain City. His team has won 91 tournaments, 17 Regionals, 11 Sectionals and one State Championship in 1991, as well as WIAA runner-up in 1998. His team has qualified for the WIAA State Team Tournament six times. Larry was inducted into the WISCONSIN WRESTLING HALL OF FAME in 1983. He was named Conference Coach of the Year in 1980, 88, 90, 91, 92, 93, and 97, Wisconsin Coach of the Year in 1988, 91, and 93. Larry was also named to WHO'S WHO AMONG UNITED STATES WRESTLING COACHES IN 1988.



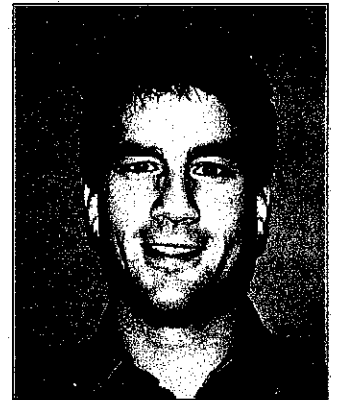
ERIC CIHA, Assistant Coach

Eric was raised in Clinton, Iowa where he attended high school and was a 2x state qualifier and a state placer in wrestling. During high school he was also a member of the Iowa Freestyle and Greco Roman Junior National Team.

He attended the University of Wisconsin-Platteville and received a Bachelors Degree in Physical Education and Technology Education. While at Platteville, he qualified for 3 Division III national tournaments and was an All-American.

After undergraduate school, he lived and worked in Minneapolis as a Fitness Consultant for Bally's Health Co. Two years later he returned to Platteville to work on his Master's in Education. While working on his masters he was an assistant coach for the university.

In 1993 he took a position as Technology Education Instructor and head wrestling coach for the School District of Mayville. He was in Mayville until just recently, taking a position for the Fond du Lac School District.
