



# *Protocol for the Return to Rowing*

## *Practice*

### **Arrival:**

- Drop off athletes in the parking spots along Ohio Street, or over at 301 Ohio Street by the trailers
  - Pulling into the boathouse parking lot is not currently permitted and stopping in traffic in front of the boathouse will not be tolerated
- Come to the boathouse dressed to row
  - The locker rooms will not be open
- All athletes will wear a mask upon arrival
- Athletes should check in with their coach, and inform them no changes to their health has occurred
- Masks are to be worn at all times in the building and on land

### **On the water:**

- Rowers may remove their masks once they have pushed off the dock
  - This is not required. Athletes may continue to wear their masks for the duration of the practice if they are more comfortable keeping it on.
- Coxswains must keep their masks on for the duration of the practice (US Rowing mandated)
- Masks must be back on by the time the boat has arrived to the dock

### **In the boathouse:**

- All athletes must have a mask on while in the building
- Athletes will continue to wear a mask while erging, or exercising indoors
- The training space upstairs has a maximum capacity of 50 people
  - If multiple programs wish to use the space at the same time, the capacity will not be exceeded
- Ergs can be used down stairs in the boat bays, or taken outside in certain conditions

### **Departure:**

- All ergs, oars, seats and riggers will be cleaned after each use
- Athletes can be picked up in the parking spots along Ohio Street or at 301 Ohio Street by the trailers
  - Again, there will be no access to the BSRA parking lot and stopping in traffic in front of the boathouse will not be tolerated
