



Virtual Engagement Policy

The purpose of the Cambridge Youth Soccer Virtual Engagement Policy is to ensure a safe and positive environment during all Club sanctioned online practices, webinars and events by providing expectations and guidelines. It is expected that all member participants (Club Officials, Team Officials, Participants, Parents and Staff) adhere to these policies and provide an environment which all individuals are treated with respect and equality.

For this purpose of this document, it should be noted that when the term “participants” is used, it is in reference to all Club Officials, Players and Parents.

1. CYS asks that all participants dress appropriately while utilizing video conferencing platforms (WebEx, Zoom, etc.).
2. The **Rule of Two** must always be in effect throughout any online/virtual events and webinars.
3. Cambridge Youth Soccer Codes of Conduct must be followed throughout any online/virtual events, practices and webinars. The environment must be free of any offensive, inappropriate or disruptive behaviour.
4. All participants are expected to behave in a respectful manner that is in line with the Club Values.
5. Remember that anything that is on your screen is visible to all participants. CYS recommends that participants use the mute function where and when they deem necessary.
6. All participants User ID's must display the Participant's First & Last name.
7. All virtual engagement and participation is optional for Recreational and Cambridge United Grassroots/Competitive participants. OPDL engagement and participation is mandatory.
8. Sharing meeting invitations/sessions with non CYS members is strictly prohibited.
9. Filming or recording of these virtual engagement sessions is strictly prohibited for the privacy of those involved. Should you wish to take a picture of the session, express consent of all involved must be given.
