Balance sheet approved. Lindsey requested more financial information be shared each month and would like to see actual vs. budget numbers so we can see how things are going throughout the year.

Registration

- Discussion was had regarding the need to clarify a Financial Policy and add it to the Registration.
 - For payment plans
 - After the first missed payment, no ice time (practices or games)
 - Must be current to resume ice time
 - 100% must be paid by February 1 in order to resume ice time and participate in post-season tournaments.
 - Kim will make initial contact regarding delinquent accounts and additional board members may be asked to help reinforce the policy if needed.
- Fees
 - CURRENT
 - Practice-Up = \$100
 - Dual Roster = \$200
 - NEW for 2022-23
 - Practice Up = 50% of age division fee
 - Dual Roster = 50% of age division fee
 - Stays the same
 - Play Up - pays the older age division fee
 - Practice Only - 50% of age division fee
