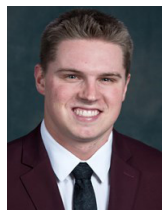

In his seventh year as the head coach at UMD, Coach Wiese led the Bulldogs to an 8-3 record and a Northern Sun Conference Northern Division Title. Since Wiese's arrival at UMD in February 2008 as the Offensive Coordinator, the Bulldogs have gone 133-22 (a record unmatched by any NCAA II school over that time period), captured two NCAA II National Championships (2008 and 2010), six Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference titles and twelve NSIC North Division Crowns, made eight NCAA II playoff appearances and produced two perfect 15-0 seasons.
