

## Volunteers on Duty (VOD)

### General

- Check the schedule on [odcsports.org](http://odcsports.org) so you know what games will be played on the various fields during your shift.
- Wear your orange ODC shirt.
- Say hi to the ump's to let them know you're there and see if they need anything. Sometimes they'll ask for water or more baseballs/softballs. Concessions will give you bottles of water for them.
- Baseballs
  - Baseballs are expensive and tend to disappear, so we keep most of our stock locked in the clubhouse.
  - Umpires get game balls from the shelves just inside the door to concessions. We should always make sure there are enough there for that day's games.
  - We will also keep a few boxes in the F1 concessions stand. Check the stock in the main concessions and move some over from F1 concessions if needed.
  - Ump's may need more balls during a game to replace those lost to home runs or foul balls. You can give them replacement balls from either spot.
- Softballs
  - Softballs are expensive and tend to disappear. We keep extras in the small shed on the back side of the fence behind home plate
- Make sure people aren't parked illegally. If they are, tell them to move. If they give you a hard time, have them towed.
- No dogs. No exceptions. If someone has a dog, they need to take it off our property immediately.
- No smoking. They need to go outside the fence.
- No weapons. ODC supports the 2<sup>nd</sup> Amendment, but we don't allow guns in the park.
- Scoreboard controllers.
  - Parents should check them out from concessions before their games. They turn in their ID as a deposit and then swap back after their games. We have a lot of new teams, coaches and parents so some may not be aware of this. If you notice a t-ball or peewee game happening without the scoreboard, you might remind the visiting team coach that it is their responsibility to have a parent run the scoreboard.
  - The controller for F1 is in the F1 press box and should stay there.
  - Instructions on using the scoreboard are on the website under documents.
- Remind coaches to rake the dirt after their games. Coaches who have the first games of the day need to line the fields. **CHALK IS ONLY FOR DIRT. CHALK NEVER GOES ON GRASS. PAINT GOES ON GRASS.**

If a situation gets heated or a parent/guest does not want to comply with a park rule after you have asked them to, reach out to a board member to assist. Do not engage in heated confrontations.

If there are any injuries on the field, please be present and offer assistance if needed. Ice is available from the concession stand for injuries as well as a basic first aid kit. A defibrillator is also located in the concession stand if needed.

**IF 911 is called - HPD, HFD, or an ambulance shows up. Please advise board leadership such as the sub board president and/or corporate board president immediately.**
