- I. Call to order

- II. Feedback from Survey:
  - o Should coaches be exempt from hours? Does this mean we need to recognize other volunteer duties (e.g., scorekeeping, locker monitor, team manager, etc.)?
  - o Multiple kid families shouldn't have extra hours?
  - o Unfair that Steel and Blades families are not required to do concessions?
  - o Assign each team with the responsibility of staffing their own home games, and X number of varsity games each (divided equally among all Bears programs)?
  - o Do we turn concessions back over to the village?
  
- III. Decisions
  - o CMH commits to continuing operating concessions in the 2024-25 season.
  - o CMH will assign varsity boys & girls games to specific teams (6U, 8U, 10U, and 12U).
  - o The number of assigned games/team will be weighted based on roster size for each respective program.
  - o Each team will be responsible to enter their assigned families for each varsity game into Dibs, so CMH knows that those games have been assigned, and which families are scheduled to work each game.
  - o Mites (8U) parents will work their own playday in exchange for revenue sharing, which will pay for a Mites tournament later in the season.





- o Each team has the option to open concessions for their own home games, if they choose to make that commitment. These games can offer a limited menu, so the entire kitchen doesn't need to be prepped and opened.
- o Public Skate – CMH to explore the possibility of other groups running concessions in exchange for an undetermined cut of the profit (e.g., NHS, H.S. Class Councils, Varsity Sports Teams, etc.).
- o No buy-out option.
- o Offer full refund of 1 registration for Concessions Manager.
