

Spring Vacation Policy

The purpose of this communication is to inform you of the South Baseball policy as it pertains to spring vacation, **March 30-April 7**. The policy is as follows:

“All players are expected to be in attendance during this vacation period unless they are with their parents on a family trip. If the player is NOT with their family, then the absences are considered UNEXCUSED, and the player may be dismissed from the team. If the absences are excused, then the player must practice for a MINIMUM of 3 days upon his return before being allowed to participate in a game.”

This policy is in effect for the orderly progression of the program. Teams cannot be developed to their fullest potential if all members are not present. Also, players who are allowed to participate under highly competitive game situations may risk injury following such a long period of inactivity.

The Freshman and J.V. teams will have 5-6 games scheduled during this time and the Varsity will play 6 games in Cincinnati. More details will follow on this trip. Our complete schedules for all levels will be listed soon on our website: www.gpsouthbaseball.com
