



COVID PROTOCOL

[Hotel-Stay or Out-of-State Tournaments]

All tournaments requiring an overnight hotel stay or out of state tournaments ("Subject Tournament") will require three step process:

1. Presentation to Board of why the Subject Tournament and how risk will be managed.
2. Board consideration.
3. (if approved) Parents must be notified of all the requirements and asked to vote (1 per child) whether or not to participate in the subject tournament.

Please, no player passing for these tournaments - it would be unfair to the parents voting no and would place the player passing players at risk.

In order to obtain approval, the DOC, DOO, and or ED ("Directors") will present the following information for consideration by the Board:

1. Rationale for why the tournament is requested:
 - Why this tournament vs. an in-state vs. non-hotel tournament?
 - Did you consider others and why was this selected?
 - What is the cancelation policy and what is the club's potential non-refundable expenses?
 - What, if any, requirements are there for staying in a hotel and any parent min out of pocket expenses
2. How will risk be managed
 - What are the current requirements tourney or state/local government in place for managing COVID risk?
 - What is your plan for complying with those guidelines?

After approval of the board, you must then present the requirements and tournament information to the parents for a vote. The vote must result in sufficient players to participate without player passing or the tournament is not approved.
