The Jr. Mavs Youth Hockey Organization is excited to be kicking off our 10th season of High School hockey. The Varsity and Junior Varsity teams are structured the same way a typical High School runs their athletic programs. Both teams participate in the Mid America High School Hockey League (MAHSHL). The number of teams formed, and the division they play in, will be determined on player registrations. Most games are played here locally in the Kansas City area, but some travel is required.

## **Both Varsity and Junior Varsity:**

- Approximately 34-38 practices per season
- Compete in a pre-season jamboree & post season championship
- Starting line up will be announced at every league game
- National Anthem will be played at the first game of the day (either JV or V)
- Three USA Hockey certified officials per league game
- Off-ice officials provided for keeping score and working the game clock
- Jr. Mavs Senior Night with recognition of players and parents before a game
- League-wide Senior game for all Seniors during the post season championship weekend
- Skills competition during the post season championship weekend

## **Registration:**

House league registrations will open in August and close on September 15th. There will be an additional \$50 charge for any registrations received after September 15th. All players will register through the KCYHA website ([www.kcyouthhockey.com](http://www.kcyouthhockey.com)). Every player must have a current USA Hockey number in order to register (must be renewed annually). ## **Equipment:**

Full protective hockey equipment is required to participate. Every new High School player will be required to purchase two game jerseys and two pairs of socks at the beginning of the season. Returning players may use their jerseys from last year. These are yours to keep until the player either outgrows or needs an-other jersey. ## **Head Coach:**

This will be Brandon's third year as High School Head Coach. He was born and raised in Apple Valley, Minnesota. He attended KU from 2000 to 2005, where he was captain of the club hockey team for three years. Brandon was the all-team leading defenseman with 101 points. After graduating, he went on to become the KU Assistant Coach for one year, before moving on to the KC Outlaws Midget Major and Midget Minor teams. As Head Coach for the Midget Minor team for three years, he led the team to two State Championship titles and an undefeated season. Since then, Brandon has been a Head Coach for both PeeWee and Bantam levels in the Kansas City area. Most recently, he was the Jr. Mavs Bantam AA Head Coach and the Jr. Mavs coaching director. Brandon is a Level 5 USA Hockey certified coach.
