

Pearland Girls Softball Association COVID Addendum to the PGSA Rules

1. Purpose

This COVID Addendum includes the measures the Pearland Girls Softball Association (“PGSA”) is actively taking to mitigate the spread of coronavirus. All PGSA teams, non-PGSA teams using facilities, Board members, managers, coaches, players, parents and spectators (“PGSA Participant”) are kindly requested to follow these rules diligently to sustain a healthy and safe environment. It is important that we all respond responsibly and transparently to these health precautions.

2. Application

- a. This addendum applies to all PGSA activities and events, and when PGSA facilities are being used.
- b. This addendum is not intended to supersede any guidelines set by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (“CDC”), state’s public health department, or other country and/or local authorities including area school districts and government agencies.

3. COVID Policy

- a. PGSA recommends and strongly encourages everyone to follow the guidelines set by the World Health Organization, Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, your state’s public health department and other county and/or local authorities including area school districts and government agencies.
- b. For the health and safety of the community PGSA serves, all PGSA Participants are expected to follow the CDC’s latest guidelines for when you can be around others after you had or likely had COVID-19, which can be found here: https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/if-you-are-sick/end-home-isolation.html?CDC_AA_refVal=https%3A%2F%2Fwww.cdc.gov%2Fcoronavirus%2F2019-ncov%2Fprevent-getting-sick%2Fwhen-its-safe.html
- c. PGSA, at its discretion and by Board approval, may implement any additional measures it determines appropriate to address COVID-related concerns.

4. Notification Procedures

- a. All PGSA Participants
 - a. If a PGSA Participant contracts COVID or exhibits COVID symptoms within ten (10) days following attendance at a PGSA activity or event, or usage of PGSA facilities, the PGSA Participant must promptly notify PGSA and other PGSA Participants who he/she had close contact with so that PGSA and other

PGSA Participants who he/she had close contact with can take any further actions necessary to avoid and/or limit any further exposure.

i. Further actions PGSA may take following such notification include:

1. Notifying individuals who likely had close contact with the PGSA Participant;
2. Postponing or rescheduling a PGSA activity or event; and
3. Cleaning and sanitizing PGSA facilities or portions thereof that the PGSA Participant used.

b. League and All-Star Teams

- a. If a manager, coach or player cannot attend a scheduled game or practice due to COVID-related reasons, he/she shall notify the manager, coach and PGSA promptly so that the team, appropriate Division Director, and the Board can make any necessary arrangements, including rescheduling the game or practice or securing eligible pickup players.
