

## In-Town Team General Manager

MYBA utilizes high school volunteer coaches for upper programs. Girls 6/7/8 and Boys 5/6 and 7/8 use high school coaches. All in-town teams with high school coaches require a parent General Manager.

### **General Manager Responsibilities**

- Provide oversight and guidance on successful operation of team
  - Guidance is the key word. High school coaches are young adults that are volunteering, learning, and gaining experience from their coaching opportunity. A new experience means mistakes are possible and that is ok. Oversight is important to help coaches maintain the right trajectory with their teams.
  - GMs, grade coordinators, and MYBA In-Town Coordinator should play the role of mentors for the High School coaches.
- Ensure the high school coaches provide clear team communications
  - GM can help with team communication or oversee coaches communications
- Provide guidance to coaches, as necessary, on MYBA policies of playing time, sportsmanship, working with kids, etc.
  - GM should work with grade coordinators and MYBA In-Town Coordinator for necessary guidance
- Attend games as spectator. Check-in with coaches as necessary
- Attend clinics as necessary - at least one parent must attend the weekly clinics
  - GM can coordinate this responsibility among other program parents if desired
