



## All-Star – Parents Creed

MOYSC pays:

Softball for the player All-Star shirt, two jerseys, Texas DIAMOND registration fees

Baseball for the player All-Star cap, two jerseys and Centex registration fees

For softball, Texas DIAMOND all-star rules state that a player is not required to play in a game. That is only a requirement for regular season games. For baseball, Centex all-star rules state that teams bat the entire roster during games.

There is no guarantee that players will play the same position or bat in the order as the spring season. Player's position is up to the coach and will be based on what is needed to help the team win.

All-Star selection is a privilege and if selected, requires a solid commitment from coaches, players and parents.

MOYSC expects parents to abide by coaching staff decisions with respect to their child.

MOYSC expects parents to behave appropriately in practices, scrimmage games, and tournaments. Your attitude and behavior is a reflection of the MOYSC league.

MOYSC has a zero tolerance stance on any MOYSC player, coach, parent, or spectator being involved in any type of confrontation or inappropriate behavior. Immediate removal from the team will be the possible outcome.

When used in this document "parents" refers to all relatives and friends representing a player.

Player must submit a copy of the birth certificate to the All-Star coach or team bookkeeper as soon as possible.

All-Star practice times and frequency is up to the head coach. Coaches expectations are as follows but not limited to:

- All players will attend all practices and game as required unless otherwise excused by the coach
- Players will notify coaches in a timely manner of any practice or game that will be missed
- Coaches may or may not have practice during the heat of the day to help condition players for tournament play
- If an issues arises where a parent does not agree with a coach's decision during the game or practice, the issue should be discussed within 24 hours of the event. The issue must always be addressed and resolved behind closed doors, never in front of players, parents or children.
- Coaches are expected to notify players of any schedule changes in a timely manner

Parents do not coach and/or umpire from the stands, this is very hard with the excitement of the game but a coach at times will instruct players to make certain plays and coaching from the stands creates confusion on the field.

If brought to the attention of the league commissioner, parents that do not follow these expectations will have a meeting with the head coach and commissioner to address the situation. Following this meeting, it is possible that a player is removed from an All-Star team for a parent's behavior.
