Return to Practice Plan



This policy is in full compliance with WAHA, USA Hockey, Wisconsin DHS, and the Ashland County Health department.

The following will be strictly enforced. Please abide by all the following:

- Players are not to enter the rink until a coach is present. Players, Goalies and Coaches may arrive no more than 15 minutes prior to start time. Early arrivals should wait in their vehicle until the building is clear to enter; do not gather at the door waiting to enter. No bags are allowed in the rink_(exception goalies). All players should be fully dressed when entering the arena with the exception of skates, helmets, and gloves (players who cannot tie their own skates should enter the arena with skate guards on).
- Players will enter the rink through the main entrance and go to one of the designated spots along the glass and stay 6 feet apart
- As soon as the ice is clear the players can enter the ice
- After practice, players will leave immediately through doors 3&4 where parents should let the skaters come to them
- No spectators will be allowed in the rink, except for U6 and under.
 - U6 and under will be allowed one parent per skater in the rink during practice. Parents will also need to wear a face mask at all time, and social distance
- Locker rooms and the concession area will be locked
- Players will need to bring their own labeled water bottle
- All players, coaches, team managers and the Zamboni driver will always need to wear a face covering.
 - The mask policy will be constantly reviewed during the season abiding by WAHA, current state and local requirements
- Practice CDC recommended social distancing
- Practice healthy hygiene and handwashing recommended by the CDC
- The facility will be sanitized on a regular basis

Covid-19 is a fluid situation-updates will be made to this policy according to state and local guidelines
