Reports:

President's Report: Mindy

The Booster Club will not sell yard signs this Spring because DHS will most likely offer them. Molly suggested future Hornet signs for incoming 9th Graders could be sold instead. Mindy will look into this after the auction. Molly also asked if students could donate services such as lawn mowing for the upcoming online auction. It was agreed that this would be allowed but students should be very specific on their availability and time commitment.

Scholarship Committee update: Molly

The Booster Club will award one female and one male Senior a \$1,000 each scholarship. The requirements to apply are: the applicants must be an athlete all 4 years, have a 3.0 GPA or higher, must have been accepted to a college, and their family must be a Booster Club member by March 15, 2021. Seniors must submit an application and a 600 word or more essay detailing future goals and how this money will help achieve these goals. They can also attach a list of accomplishments. Applications are due by April 19 and are available online through Student VUE or a paper copy be submitted through the main office Booster Club mailbox or via e mail. The winners will be announced May 3. Winners will be notified by e mail to set up a time and date to FaceTime and they will be announced live on FaceTime. Currently the committee has 7 members and an odd number is required to confirm a majority vote. Seniors parents and Board Members will not be allowed to join the committee. All applicant's names will be kept anonymous. Molly is hoping to form a committee that includes parents with children in different sports.

Treasurer's Report: Kellie

The budget was passed out and is attached. Kellie noted she is using a new budget form. Senior yard signs will be removed from the budget and a line item will be added for the Online Auction. Football has a few new deposits and Baseball got a donation. Kellie also noted that the budget obligation for landscaping has been met.
