

## Calumet Colosseum Usage Regulations

In order to minimize the likelihood of the Calumet Colosseum being shut down this hockey season, we are asking parents and players to adhere to the following guidelines that Calumet Township and the Calumet Hockey Association have laid out to enter the building and the MAHA guidelines while playing hockey.

- If you or your child are ill, feel ill or have recently tested positive for Covid-19, PLEASE STAY HOME
- Wear a mask when entering the building and while in public areas of the building
- When entering the building, use the door labeled ENTER and when exiting, use the door labeled EXIT
- There will be a sign in sheet when you enter the building
- 10U, 12U, and 14U parents please drop your child off 15 minutes before practice and return to pick them up without socializing in the building
- Please have your child their own water bottle and label it with their name
- Parents drop your player off 45 minutes before games and enter the building at game time and leave in a timely fashion
- 6U and 8U parents please have your child dressed before you come in the building and utilize the rink for tying skates--do not use the lobby to finish dressing--there is fresh rubber flooring surrounding the entire rink. If you are not able to bring your child dressed, please use the allotted locker room.
- Please inform your child to undress and vacate the locker room in a timely fashion
- Wash your hands and utilize the hand sanitizer stations
- Locker rooms will be sanitized between each team/group after each use. As teams get formed a representative from each team will be responsible for cleaning the locker room.
- Private rentals are required to sign a waiver before stepping on the ice

The 2020-21 hockey season is unfolding in unprecedented fashion. We are asking people to be smart and not jeopardize the season or the building being shut down, by following the rules. This can be accomplished by minimal entry into the building and by minimizing the time you spend there.
