



SAFE REOPENING PLAN

This plan does not need to be submitted at this time. This plan is to be used to prepare when businesses open per the Governor’s Order. The County will not require approval for this plan.

Businesses must implement all mandatory measures listed in A and B below. Businesses shall select applicable measures listed in C and D below and be prepared to explain why any measure that is not implemented is inapplicable to the business. Businesses shall also provide specific details regarding their Safe Reopening Plan pertaining to their business in section E below.

A. Signage (Mandatory):

- Signage at each public entrance of the facility to inform all employees and customers that they should: avoid entering the facility if they have a cough or fever; wear facial coverings, maintain a minimum six-foot distance from one another; and not shake hands or engage in any unnecessary physical contact.
- Signage posting a copy of the Safe Reopening Plan at each public entrance to the facility.

B. Measures To Protect Employee Health (Mandatory):

- Teleworking opportunities have been maximized.
- All employees have been told not to come to work if sick.
- All employees must have temperature taken upon reporting to work; if 100 degrees or more, should not be allowed in workplace. Employees must be screened for symptoms (cough, shortness of breath or trouble breathing, headache, fever, chills, muscle or body aches, fatigue, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, new loss of taste or smell, nausea or vomiting, diarrhea, exposure to individuals who have tested positive for COVID-19)
- All employees must wear facial coverings in the workplace, if within six feet of others.
- All desks or individual work stations are separated by at least six feet.
- Break rooms, bathrooms, and other common areas are being disinfected frequently, on the following schedule:

CYB will use city Parks/fields (Chase Field, Poinsettia, Claveras and Alga Norte) for CYB activities and signage is properly posted. Each parent of the participant will review and sign the CYB Reopening plan before participation. Players will be reminded to stay on the field for the duration of practice avoiding common areas and bathrooms. If it is necessary to use a bathroom a coach will sanitize before and after use.

- Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) has been provided at a level appropriate to employee job duties (describe below)

Participants will be required to use face coverings while entering and exiting the field. On the field, face coverings will be recommended and mandatory only if at any time social distancing less than 6ft is necessary.

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B. Measures To Protect Employee Safety (Mandatory) Continued:

Soap and water are available to all employees at the following location(s):

Soap and sanitizer will be on site and provided by CYB.

Copies of the Protocol have been distributed to all employees.

C. Measures To Protect Customer Safety (Check all that apply to the facility):

Limit the number of customers in the store at any one time to which allows for customers and employees to easily maintain at least six-foot distance from one another at all practicable times.

All patrons/visitors must have facial coverings in their possession and wear them within 6 ft. of another person

Curbside or outdoor service is made available where feasible.

Optional – Describe other measures:

-Maximum of 12 participants on the field.
-Screen participants before entering any facility
-Sanitize all equipment necessary.
-Mandatory hand washing or use hand sanitizer before allowing participation and after participation.
-Practice will be organized so that players will not intermingle and social distancing of six feet or greater can be achieved.

D. Measures To Keep People At Least Six Feet Apart (Check all that apply to the facility):

Placing signs outside the store reminding people to be at least six feet apart, including when in line. Including encouragement for pedestrian traffic to follow one-way migration paths, if appropriate.

Placing tape or other markings at least six feet apart in customer line areas inside the store and on sidewalks at public entrances with signs directing customers to use the markings to maintain distance.

All employees have been instructed to maintain at least six feet distance from customers and from each other, except employees may momentarily come closer when necessary to accept payment, deliver goods or services, or as otherwise necessary.

Appointment system is utilized, when appropriate.

Optional – Describe other measures:

-Player equipment will be placed on the fence outside the dugout 6 feet apart
-Dugout will not be occupied by any player or coach at any time during practice
-Practices will be designed to maintain social distancing of six feet or greater.

Carlsbad Youth Baseball (CYB) Safe Reopening Plan

A copy of this plan will be provided to all Volunteers, Coaches, Parents or Guardians.

Definitions:

Volunteers: CYB Board Member, Commissioner or Team Parent

Coaches: Team Manager or Assistant Coach

Participants: Players registered through CYB that are on a stable team roster

Parents/Guardians: Legal entity responsible for the participant

HEALTH PROTOCOLS FOR CYB BOARD MEMBERS:

- All parents/guardians of youth participants will be required to sign the CYB COVID Parent Waiver prior to participation.
- In addition to the CYB COVID Parent Waiver, all volunteer coaches must sign an acknowledgement form indicating that they agree to follow this safe reopening plan prior to participation: CYB COVID Parent Waiver.
- CYB will acknowledge and support decisions to not participate among youth, parents, and volunteers who are uncomfortable participating for any reason.
- CYB will divide participants into "stable teams" limiting team participation to 12 (not including coaches). These teams should be consistent and rostered as such.
- CYB will train all coaches and volunteers on appropriate cleaning and disinfection, hand hygiene, etiquette per CDC guidelines.

Ensure screening of volunteers, coaches and participants before entering any field:

- Send home any person who has any of the following new or worsening signs or symptoms of possible COVID-19: Cough - Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing - Chills - Repeated shaking with chills - Muscle pain - Headache - Sore throat - Loss of taste or smell - Diarrhea - Feeling feverish or a measured temperature greater than or equal to 100.0 degrees Fahrenheit - Known close contact with a person who is lab confirmed to have COVID-19.
- Do not allow any person with new or worsening signs or symptoms listed above to return until: In the case of an individual who was diagnosed with COVID-19, all three of the following criteria are met: at least 3 days (72 hours) have passed since recovery (resolution of fever without the use of fever-reducing medications); and the individual has improvement in symptoms (e.g., cough, shortness of breath); and at least 10 days have passed since symptoms first appeared; or in the case of a participant, volunteer or coach who has symptoms that could be COVID-19 and does not get evaluated by a medical professional or tested for COVID-19, the individual is assumed to have COVID-19, and the individual may not return until they have completed the same three-step criteria listed above; or if the individual has symptoms that could be COVID-19 and wants to return to CYB activity before completing the above self-isolation period, the individual must obtain a medical professional's note clearing the individual for return based on an alternative diagnosis.

HEALTH PROTOCOLS FOR FIELD USAGE:

- Frequently clean and disinfect any regularly touched surface per CDC guidelines.

- CYB will provide team managers with hand sanitizer to be used before entering the field of play and leaving the field of play. The hand sanitizer will be readily available if needed at any time during the activity.
- Participants will use only their personal equipment during the activity, no exceptions.
- **Restrooms:** The facilities are maintained by the City of Carlsbad and if any participant needs to use the restroom a coach/parent or volunteer will ensure the proper sanitizing procedures are being followed per CDC guidelines.
- Face Coverings will be required by all to enter and exit the field. Coaches within 6 feet or less of players must wear a face covering.
- Personal equipment bags will be spaced along the inside fence line and outside of the dugout, spaced at least 6ft apart.
- Hydration (water) will be supplied only by the participant and stored within the individuals equipment bag. No food items are allowed past the entrance to the field of play.
- Dugouts will not be used at any time during CYB activities.
- Only one rostered team of 12 or less players will be able to participate on the field. Practices will be designed to maintain a social distance of 6 feet or more. Face coverings are recommended during participation. Teams must be comprised of a stable group of 12 or less, no swapping in and out of players.
- CYB provided equipment will be limited to the following: Pitching machines, bases and baseballs. These items will be sanitized by the coach per CDC guidelines before and after each team usage.

DROP OFF AND PICK UP:

- Parents should ideally drop off kids and pick them up from practice. If parents choose to stay and observe, they may do so outside the fenced field of play while keeping proper distancing from kids and others. If bleachers are used, the individual is responsible for wiping down their area with sanitizing wipes. If at any time a safe distance cannot be kept, a face covering is required.
- Coaches will create clear pathways into and out of the field so the stable teams are not coming into contact with other stable teams upon entering or exiting the field.
- CYB will Instruct participants and coaches that all recognition protocols involving physical contact such as hugs, high-fives, etc. are not allowed. At all times coaches and volunteers shall encourage the use of non-contact recognition that meet social distancing guidelines of six feet or greater.
- CYB will require all participants to wash or sanitize their hands before entering the facility. Hand sanitizer will be available for each stable team.
- Coaches will screen all participants, coaches, and volunteers before entering any field:
- Send home any participant, coach or volunteer who has any of the following new or worsening signs or symptoms of possible COVID-19: Cough - Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing - Chills - Repeated shaking with chills - Muscle pain - Headache - Sore throat - Loss of taste or smell - Diarrhea -Feeling feverish or a measured temperature greater than or equal to 100.0 degrees Fahrenheit - Known close contact with a person who is confirmed to have COVID-19.

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- Do not allow participants, coaches or volunteers with new or worsening signs or symptoms listed above to return until: In the case of an individual who was diagnosed with COVID-19, all three of the following criteria are met: at least 3 days (72 hours) have passed since recovery (resolution of fever without the use of fever-reducing medications); and the individual has improvement in symptoms (e.g., cough, shortness of breath); and at least 10 days have passed since symptoms first appeared; or in the case of a participant who has symptoms that could be COVID-19 and does not get evaluated by a medical professional or tested for COVID-19, the individual is assumed to have COVID-19, and the individual may not return until they have completed the same three-step criteria listed above; or if the individual has symptoms that could be COVID-19 and wants to return to participation before completing the above self-isolation period, the individual must obtain a medical professional's note clearing the individual for return based on an alternative diagnosis.
- If an individual has had close contact (less than 6 feet) for 15 minutes or more with a person with Covid-19 symptoms or a person who has tested positive for Covid-19 (symptomatic or not) then per CDC guidelines that person should stay home for 14 days from the date of contact and shall not participate in any baseball related activities (see the following link for more details: <https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/php/public-health-recommendations.html>).
- Participants will handle and care for their own equipment at all times.
- Coaches and volunteers will monitor participant compliance of this plan.
- Coaches must notify the Player Agent (contact details below) if any participant, coach, or volunteer has been tested positive for COVID-19.
