ATHLETE'S "BILL OF RIGHTS"

Every participant who competes in the San Gabriel Valley Jr. All-American Football Conference is afforded the right to:

1. To Sign up for a Football Team or Cheer Squad within the legal parameters of the San Gabriel Valley Jr. All-American Football Conference rules.
2. Be instructed by a Coach who places the athlete first, the team second, the coach third, winning fourth, and be able to use play as an opportunity to try out life without adult-imposed pressure to be a winner.
3. Have equal access to practice and compete in the the San Gabriel Valley Jr. All-American Football Conference organization.
4. Voice options openly to the coach without fear of repercussion.
5. Report any physical pain to the coach and the parents without fear of reprisal and loss of self esteem.
6. Be provided with safe equipment essential to the playing of the game.
7. Be coached by those who have been trained or made aware of the various stages of emotional and psychological developments of youth and to be treated on a level equivalent to his/her emotional and physical maturity.
8. Be properly supervised at all practices and contests.
9. Be trained with respect by all envolved with the San Gabriel Valley Jr. All-American Football program.
