Ref coordinators get paid \$60/game to ref

I would like to see the younger refs given the opportunity to be mentored more and receive more games. Only one Level 3 ref should be reffing a U10 game when Level 1's are available.

You get a higher level of pay per game depending on the officials USA level. Level 3 and 4 officials get a \$5 bonus for each game they officiate with a level 1 or 2 official. We are implementing a bonus depending on how many games the official does in one season.

We all ask for respect , we do give that to the refs and we are concern as there is not many refs. But some of the refs took this to extremes and now they think they are they can say what ever they want to coaches. This should be same for anyone , stop with treating of suspensions. this all apply to everyone same for refs
