Call to Order and Introduction of Board Members

Scott provided a recap of the year.

-We had 208 players in the association in association. 168 were returning players and 40 new players.

-We will have 18 players age out next year. We had registrations from 18 different zip codes.

-Here are the team numbers:

Mites- 85

Squirts- 33

PeeWees- 35

Bantams- 30

10U- 13

12U-12

-Each team averaged about 82 ice touches this season. Each team had at least 1 solo practice and 14 skating clinics. Each team averaged about 30-32 games.

-Scott read through the coaches comments and overall everyone had a great season.

-Squirt B and PeeWee B were district champs and the PeeWee B team went to regions. The 10U girls took 2nd place at Districts.

-The Association brought in \$71, 000 in registration fees.

- This year the association had some new and exciting things happening. They hired a new skating coach, they utilized Gustavus players to assist with clinics, we had 16 goalie clinics, offered 507 dryland and started coaching clinics.

- Moving forward next year the association is excited to move forward with a dryland center, starting Bingo at Niesens and the 50/50 raffle in Henderson. Scott is also working with the community center on dasher boards and advertising to bring in some sponsorship revenue.

Comments:

-Parents were present and gave some feedback on the mite program and were hoping that in the future the Mites could have more “games” and competitive aspects so that when they attend the cross ice events that they have more game knowledge. There were also some concerns about bullying at the mite level and other behaviors.

-Chris Miller was present and asked if the HS teams could help with the mite and squirt levels and he reports that in order to letter at the HS level next year players will need to participate in the youth program.
