1. Minutes

The minutes of the May meeting were approved.

1. Treasurer’s Report

A copy of the treasurer’s report was handed out. The attendance policy was discussed. Every school gets a twenty-five dollar credit for each meeting they attend. If you attend eight meetings during the school year, your school will not have to pay any fees for attendance.

1. Old Business

1. PLACT

1. Soccer

Soccer will be played at the OKC Optimist Soccer Club in Dolese Park, north of PC High School and west of Meridian on NW 50th. The 2019 schedule will be on the website the week of September 1st.

The number of teams from each school should have been turned in at the meeting. Email your team roster to Keiffer by September 5th.

Games will start September 7th and will end the last weekend in October. Thursday's games start in October.

Soccer fees will be due at the September meeting. The forfeit fees for this year are: kindergarten-\$25, 1st through 4th - \$35 and 5th through 8th-\$50.

Each school was assigned a Friday to help stock the concession stand and cleaning the restrooms. Two volunteers from each school will need to go to the Optimist Soccer Club at 5:30 on their assigned Friday. Representatives will check in with Dave Sergeant at the concession stand at 5:30. We will alternate every other weekend. The schedule was in an email that Keiffer sent out and it will be posted on the website.

Please ask all the coaches to bring a first aid kit to the soccer games. It would also be a good idea to have ice or instant ice packs.

Ask your parents to leave quickly after each game to free up parking spaces.

1. Volleyball

Volleyball games will begin on the weekend of September 7th and continue until the end of October. The end-of-year tournaments are tentatively set for October 25th – 27th.

Casady will host a middle school boys tournament for 6th – 8th grade boys September 21st.

Rosary will host a middle school boys tournament for 6th – 8th grade boys November 2nd – 3rd.

The fee for volleyball will remain \$325 per team.
