Girls Basketball Loses on Buzzer Beater at Fenwick

The 10-3 GBS Girls Basketball team lost at the buzzer at Fenwick on Friday night, 50-49.

Down seven with two and half minutes to go, the Titans mounted a furious comeback. A backdoor basket by Julie DiSano on a nice feed from Libbie Vanderveen cut the margin to five. The Titans forced a turnover, and a DiSano three on a great pass from Makayla Stadler cut the margin to 2. Stadler stole the ensuing inbounds pass and scored, tying the game.

GBS forced another turnover, and Stadler took the ball to basket and was fouled with 12 seconds left, and made both free throws to put the Titans ahead by 2. After forcing an apparent turnover that would have ended the game, Fenwick was awarded the ball with 2.2 seconds left and hit a three at the buzzer.

DiSano led the team with 13 points, including 3 three pointers. Stadler had 12 points, 8 rebounds, 8 assists, and 6 steals. Vanderveen had 6 points, 8 rebounds, 4 assists and 3 steals. Kristin Ralston scored 9, Annie Streb added 6, and Challen Flaws dropped in a 3 pointer and had 3 steals. Grace O'Brien and Emily Castelli provided key minutes for the squad, as well.

The team is now 10-3 overall.

The girls will take on St. Charles East at the Wheaton North tournament on Wednesday, December 26 at 1:30 p.m.



Boys Basketball Splits Games, Heads to Wheeling Tourney as #1 seed

Boys Basketball beat Warren 54-50 in a non-conference game Friday night at the Titan Dome.

Down nine points to start the fourth quarter, the Titans (9-2) came out with an intense final eight minutes defensively and on offense as they outscored the Blue Devils 21-8. They went 5-for-5 from the field and 9-for-9 from the free throw line.

Glenbrook South scored 10 unanswered points in just over two plus minutes. Will King (9 points) made a layup that put the Titans ahead 43-42 with 5:50 remaining.

The lead changed each way on successive baskets and then Warren's Jordan Johnson hit a short jump shot for 2 of his 8 points, tying the game at 46-46 at the two-minute mark.

The Titans' Dom Martinelli, who had a game-high 26 points, dropped in six straight free throws and Gavin Morse (8 points) added the other two from the charity stripe for the four-point difference.

"We didn't come out with much fire the first three quarters," Glenbrook South coach Phil Ralston told the Daily Herald. "I give them credit. My kids came out and played a fourth quarter. They fought and they were able to hold (Warren) off. Their kids were physical and I thought they shot the ball better than we thought. We just went back to our basics with pass cuts and screening while going to the basket."

Earlier in the week, The Titans lost to Maine South 37-36 on a controversial three-pointer at the buzzer by the Redhawks that was originally called a two but changed after the officials huddled.

The Titans play Taft at 2 p.m., on Weds., in the first round of the Wheeling Hardwood Classic holiday tournament.



Girls Gymnastics Beats #1 Ranked New Trier

The meet against New Trier, the #1 ranked team in state, has been long anticipated all season.

The Varsity Girls' Gymnastics team knew this was going to be a pivotal point in determining the seriousness of their competitive commitment to the run up to the state series in February.

The Titans prevailed with a winning score of 145.05 to 142.50.

Standout performances included:

- Winning as a team each of all four events
- Jenna Hartley winning on vault with 9.65
- Sheena Graham winning on bars with 9.40
- Jenna Hartley placing 2nd on beam with 9.25
- Jenna Hartley winning floor exercise with 9.35 and Sheena Graham coming in 2nd with 9.30
- Jenna Hartley won all-around with 37.30 and Sheena Graham placed 2nd with 37.15

The varsity girls' gymnastics team goes into winter break undefeated in dual meet competition and in first place in conference.





Wrestling

On Thursday, Dec. 20, the Titans and Spartans competed and raised money for the American Heart Association in honor of former Glenbrook North coach and teacher Mark Rebora, who died after suffering a heart attack on March 18.

The host Spartans won 46-21 over the Titans, in a Central Suburban Conference crossover held at Glenbrook North.

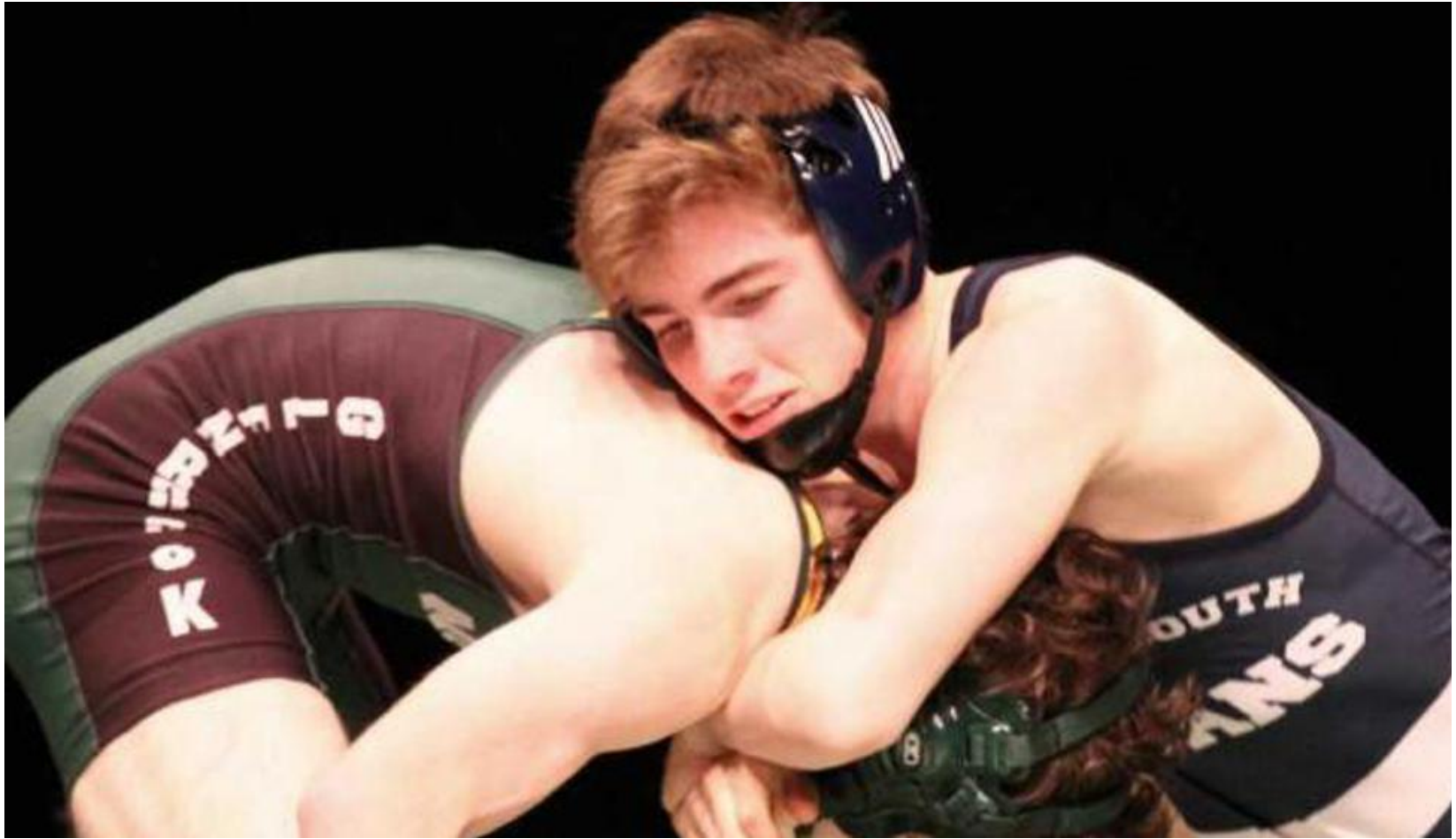
For GBS, a team with five underclassmen and only one senior simply ceded too many bonus points for coach Pat Castillo.

"You just can't give up that many pins," Castillo told the Glenview Lantern. "It's a young team but a lot of them wrestled varsity last year and they know that in big matches you can't get pinned, especially when we're (close) in the matches like that. They know to wrestle a little bit harder and smarter in those close matches."

The Titans got pins from Will Collins (138) and George Papagiannopoulos (160), and decision wins from KP Santos (106), Ryan Brown (126), and Cam Mercer (195).

The freshman Collins improved to 21-1 with his win, a pin just over a minute into his match at 138.

"Will had great success as a middle school wrestler and he's (acclimating) right into the high school level," Castillo said. "There are a lot of juniors and seniors he's going against but he has handled himself pretty well."
