INHOUSE DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM

- **Fall Season:** Monday October 13th – Saturday December 6th
- **Winter Season:** Monday January 5th – Saturday February 28th
 - All games will be held at various Shakopee Elementary Schools
- **1st / 2nd Grade: 6 teams**
 - Practice on Tuesdays *60 minutes between 6:00 - 8:00pm*
 - 3 vs 3 scrimmages on Saturdays *45-minute games between 9am - 2pm*
 - Total of 6 games *First game on Oct 25th | Last Game on Dec 6th*
- **3rd / 4th Grade: 6 teams**
 - Practice on Mondays *60 minutes between 6:00 - 8:00pm*
 - 4 vs 4 games on Saturdays in fall *45-minute games between 9am – 2pm*
 - 5 games & Year End Tournament *First game on Oct 25th | Tournament Dec 6th*

*Elementary Gyms are not guaranteed to be Practice/Game ready more than 5 minutes before they start. Please wait to escalate any concerns until that time has passed.

*Note that adjustments may be made to days/times based on outside factors-any practice/game cancellations will be decided and communicated by the Association.



COACHES

- **We strive for each Team to have two Coaches**

- All Coaches are parent volunteers, and we cannot thank you enough!
- We structure as Co-Coaches and not Head/Assistant
- Coaches will maintain equal playing time for all players assuming attendance and positive attitude
- Some teams are still looking for more parents to help during practice and games
 - If you are interested in helping coach, please reach out to Kelsey Rooda or your team's current coach

PARENTS

- **Two-Way Communication is expected between Coaches and Parents**
 - ***Sports Engine is Primary Communication Platform & Source of Truth for the Schedule***



- Download the App and login with the email used for registration
- All Rosters and Schedules are posted there
- The App can be used for quick and easy messaging to/from coaches and parents

- **Parents:**

- Be Supportive of Coaches and Players
- Follow the 24-hour rule prior to addressing a concern with a coach
- Each team will be responsible for providing 1 parent to help run the game timer and keep score (3rd/4th).
 - Scoring is only for 3rd/4th grade and is only a team score. We will not keep player stats.
 - 1st and 2nd grade do not keep stats or score.
 - These should be assigned by the coach prior to the games in order to allow games to start on time and with minimal confusion



UNIFORMS

- **Jersey**

- Each player has a practice (non-numbered) reversible jersey. These are theirs to keep and can use throughout each year of the program
- 3rd & 4th grade will be issued numbered uniforms for games.
 - 1st/2nd grade will use their practice jerseys during scrimmages
 - Game uniforms will be returned at the end of the season

- **Shooting Shirts**

- Provided to all players and is their own to keep



VOLUNTEER REQUIREMENTS

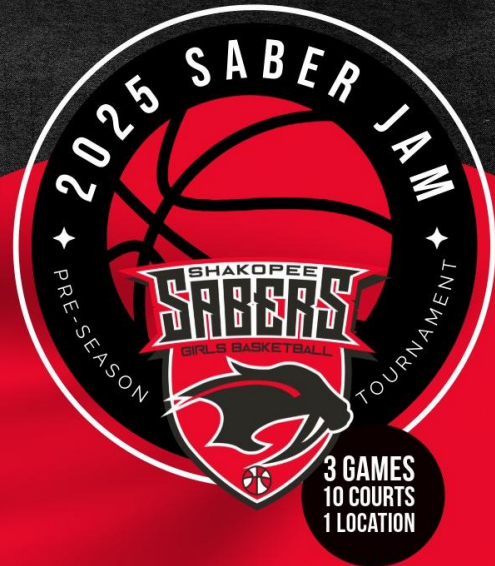
Volunteer Requirement

- All Development League families are required to volunteer 4 hours (1 shift) at either Saber Jam in October or the Shoot for the Stars Tournament in December
- DIBs shifts will be released on SGBA Website in mid-Nov for SFTS & the week of Oct. 19th for Saber Jam
- Volunteer requirements are per family not per athlete

Volunteer Deposit Process

- No DIBs check needed
- New SE enhancement to avoid the invoicing done in 2024
- \$500 charge will incur on January 15th for families that do not meet the volunteer requirement
