  - a. Broncos COVID-19 Return to Play plan accepted by the school district
    - i. Temp Checks and Screenings – We will need to perform these checks before every game and practice
    - ii. Sanitation Protocol – Increased disinfection of equipment used during games and practices will occur.
    - iii. Partnering with families – Please make sure that your child's practice and game clothing is clean for every time they need to wear it. Please send your child to every game or

practice with a water bottle that will last them the entire event. Please make sure to only send your child when they are healthy.

iv. Limiting Spectators: Our current understanding is that we must limit spectators to 250 at a time. A recent Governor order is saying that we cannot have any spectators for practices or games. We are working with the school to understand this more.
