1. Minutes

The minutes of the February and March meetings were approved.

2. Treasurers Report

The fee for the track meet is \$150 per school or \$9.00 per student. If you have not already done so, please mail the track fee as well as any outstanding basketball or PLACT training fees to Mike Milligan.

All outstanding fees must be paid in full to enroll any teams in volleyball or soccer next year.

The treasurer’s reports from the February and March meetings were approved. Thank you, Mike, for your excellent work as treasurer as well as all the other jobs you take on to keep the CGSAA running smoothly and efficiently.

3. Unfinished Business

The following volleyball rule to allow boys’ teams to participate in the league was approved.

Rule 2. Teams will consist of all girls or all boys. BOYS teams will play up one grade level (for example, a 5th grade boys team will compete in the 6th grade league) and will abide by the rules of that league.

2a. 8th grade boys teams will play in the 8th grade girls league HOWEVER the boys may not block or jump to attack the ball in front of the 10-foot line

2b. If two grade levels of boys combine to form a team, they will play up a grade level from their oldest player (for example, a 4/5th combined team will play in the 6th grade league.)

4. Soccer

The number of soccer teams from each school will be due at the August meeting. Games will begin the weekend of September 7th. Keiffer will need the player and coach rosters by September 5. The fees for soccer will be the same as last year.

5. Volleyball

All Saints will be hosting a preseason invitational tournament and will be emailing the schools invited.

The number of volleyball teams and gym availability will be due at the August meeting. The fee will remain the same at \$325 per team.

6. Basketball

There was no basketball report.

7. Track

The track meet will be held on April 13. Enduro entries will need to be completed with name, gender and grade level by April 10 at midnight. You should get a list of entry numbers for your students before Friday, April 12.

Due to safety concerns we are paying a discus/shotput coordinator \$200 this year to run those two events. We may need to raise the fees for next year. Johnny will discuss this with Mike after the meeting.

Next year we will discuss the two track divisions and how to better divide them up if we still want to have two divisions. Currently there are 4 schools in one division and 8 in the other.

The combined 7/8th CGSAA track team has had a great response, and we are predicting more growth with that team in the future.

8. PLACT

9. New Business

Rosary was granted funding for adjustable backboards.
