Upon entry you will be asked health and safety questions and your temperature will be checked. **NO OUTSIDE FOOD AND DRINK ARE PERMITTED** in the facility and our concession stand will be open for your convenience. Any other guests not able to attend will be able to live stream all games at www.livebarn.com.

Teams, players, coaches, must wear masks while entering the facility and at all times. Each team will have an assigned entry location for each game.

2021 Carolina Amateur Hockey Association Championship Tournament COVID Protocols - NORTH CAROLINA

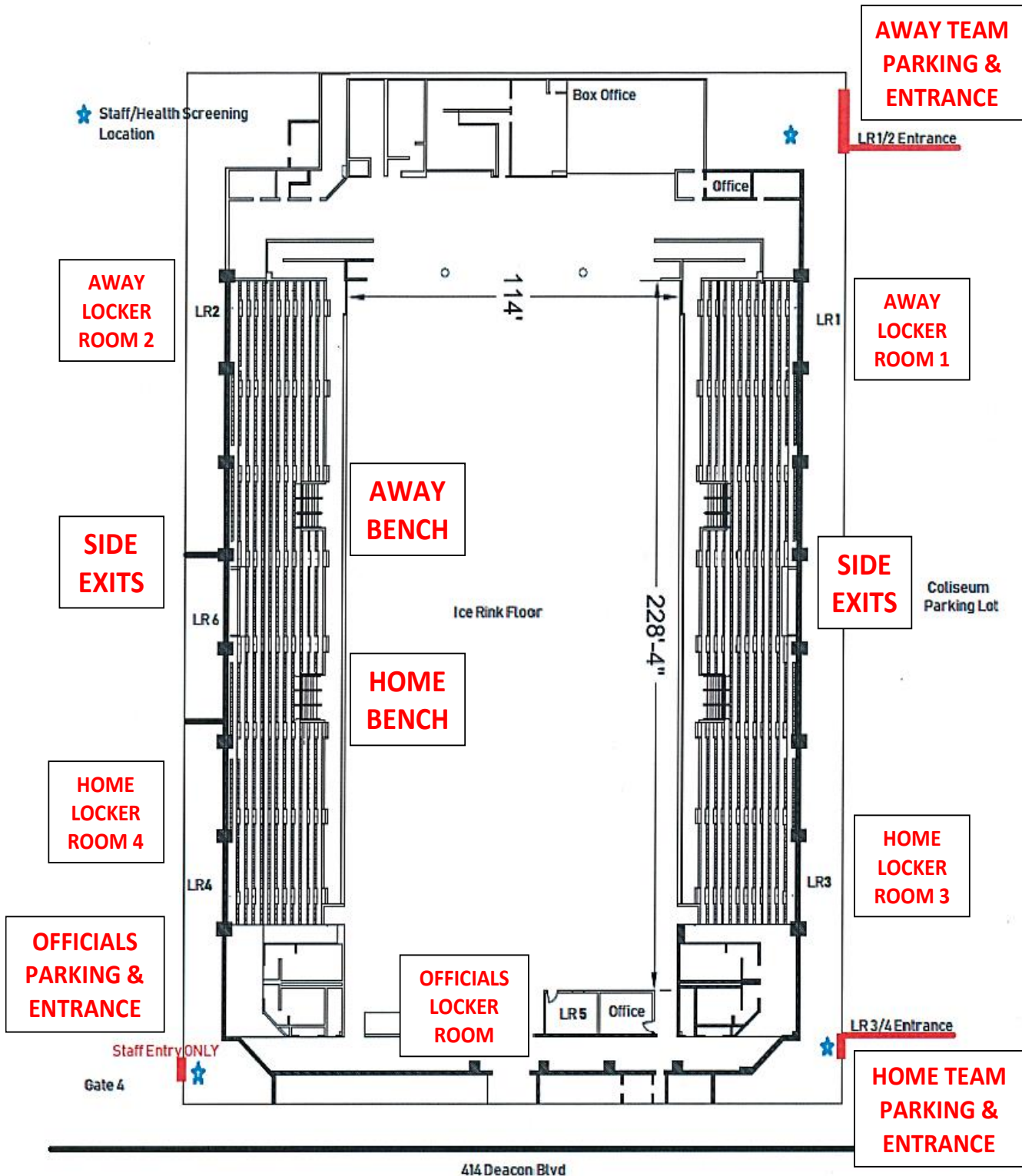
All teams must follow the current local and state COVID-19 guidelines and the CAHA COVID-19 policy. These include players wearing masks on the ice, on the bench, and any time during team activities at the rink or in any other location.

- Only 1 spectator per player is allowed in the building. All spectators must enter through the same door that their team enters.
- There will be separate entrances for Home and Visitor teams.
- Spectators must have a temperature check, wear a mask, and check-in with the Annex staff before entering.
- Teams may enter no more than 45 minutes before game time.
- Spectators may enter no more than 15 minutes before game time.
- All players, coaches, spectators must exit via the side Exits.
- MASKS are required at all times including on the ice for players, on the benches for coaches, and in the penalty boxes for penalty box attendants.
- EJECTION penalty will be enforced by referees and Tournament Director for any coach or player not wearing a mask as required. Zero Tolerance and no warnings will be given. Game will be stopped and player or coach will be removed. This is a Tournament rule and does not require an additional 1-game suspension.
- MAXIMUM 3 non-players on the bench – includes coaches, photographers, or injured players.
- MAXIMUM of 1 Penalty Box attendant per penalty box
- NO handshake lines. For Championship Games, teams will line up on their respective blue lines and each player will step forward when their name is called. Medals will be given to the coach to distribute to their players.
- NO Spectators on the ice or benches after the game.
- 1 Team photographer allowed on the bench after the game for team pictures.
- Teams must leave the locker rooms and building within 15 minutes after the end of their game.

CAHA TOURNAMENT – TEAM ENTRANCES TO WINSTON-SALEM ANNEX

- All teams must enter via the HOME or AWAY team entrances ONLY
- All players, coaches, spectators must EXIT via the SIDE EXITS
- Entrance will require temperature checks and check-in
- Arrivals – Teams no earlier than 45 minutes before game time. Spectators 15 minutes before game time.
- Departures within 15 minutes of the end of the game

2021 Carolina Amateur Hockey Association Championship Tournament Summary of Key Game Rules and Regulations

COVID – Wearing Masks

All scorekeepers, coaches, players on the ice, referees, and spectators must wear masks at all times.

Uniform Colors

- HOME – Light Jerseys, AWAY – dark jerseys

Start Times

- Games will begin on time and we will not begin games early.

Game Length, Curfew, Ice Resurfacing

- Warm up - five (5) minutes. The warmup clock will start as soon as the referees have completed their safety checks, put nets in place and the Zamboni doors are closed.
- 14U – 16-minute periods, 16U & 18U – 17-minute periods
- Minor Penalties – 2 minutes, Major Penalties – 5 minutes, Misconduct penalties – 10 minutes
- Each team is permitted one time-out of 60 seconds, whether in regulation or overtime, per the USA Hockey Playing Rules.
- All preliminary, semi-final and championship games shall be continued to determine a winner.
- All games in all age groups - Ice shall be resurfaced between the 2nd and 3rd periods of all preliminary, semi-final and championship games. Ice resurfacing during overtime play of semi-final or championship games shall be at the Tournament Director's discretion.
- If, due to extenuating circumstances, running time must be used, the minutes shall be increased by fifty percent (50%) with the following exception: running time will be used when the score differential reaches five (5) or more goals beginning in the third period. Once the score differential is reduced to four (4) goals the clock will go back to stop time.

Scorekeeping

The Scorekeeper will record shots on net. A shot on net is a shot that would have gone in the net if the goalie was not there. A goal is a shot on net.

Bench Management

Only players in uniform and coaches (maximum of three) listed on the certified team roster will be allowed on the bench. Suspended players or coaches may not be within the immediate vicinity of the player's bench.

Overtime

Preliminary Round Games

If the game is tied following regulation play, one five (5) minute sudden-death overtime period shall be played. At the completion of the third period, the tied teams shall receive a two (2) minute rest period. The teams will remain on the ice. The teams shall change ends. If the score is tied at the end of the five (5) minute sudden-death overtime period, there shall be a shootout. The winner of the shootout will be credited with one additional goal in the final score.

Championship Games

If the game is tied following regulation play, one (1) sudden-death overtime period shall be played. At the completion of the third period, the tied teams shall receive a two (2) minute rest period. The length of the overtime shall be equal to the length of the third period and shall be sudden death. Teams shall switch ends at the end of the third period. If the score is tied at the end of the sudden-death overtime period, there shall be a shootout. The winner of the shootout will be credited with one additional goal in the final score.

Shootout – all games

The **Shootout** will be conducted as follows:

- A shootout is defined as a player attempting to score a goal and the opposing goalkeeper attempting to stop the shooter from scoring the goal.
- The referee shall call the two captains to the referee's crease to flip a coin to determine which team takes the first shot. The home team shall call the coin toss. The winner of the coin toss will have the choice whether his/her team will shoot first or second.
- All goalkeepers and all players from both teams listed on the official game sheet shall be eligible to participate in the shootout.
- The goalkeepers will defend the net they were defending in the 3rd period.
- Any penalized player whose penalty had not been completed when the overtime period ended or who receives a penalty during a shootout procedure is not eligible to participate in any portion of the shootout procedure(s) and must remain in the penalty box.
- The shootout procedure shall begin with five (5) different individual shooters from each team taking alternate shots. The players do not need to be named beforehand.
- The goalkeepers from each team may be changed after each shot.
- The players of both teams will take the shots alternately until a decisive goal is scored. The remaining shots will not be taken.
- If after the shootout, the shootout score is still tied, there will be a sudden death shootout.

The **Sudden Death Shootout** will be conducted as follows:

- A sudden-death shootout is defined as each team attempting a shot. Should one team be successful and the other team not, the successful team shall win the shootout.
- Teams will select their shooters to participate in any order in the sudden death shootout, whether or not they shot in the previous round. The last player in the first round of the shootout may be the first player in the sudden death shootout.
- Players in a sudden death shootout shall not be allowed to take another shot until four additional shooters have completed their attempts.
- All goalkeepers and all players from both teams listed on the official game sheet shall be eligible to participate in the shootout.
- Any penalized player whose penalty had not been completed when the overtime period ended or who receives a penalty during a shootout procedure is not eligible to participate in any portion of the shootout procedure(s) and must remain in the penalty box.
- The goalkeepers from each team may be changed after each shot.
- The official scorekeeper shall record all shots taken indicating the players, goalkeeper and goals scored.
