TOURNAMENT DETAILS

- Each team guaranteed 3 games
- Each team may have up to 6 players on a roster
- 12 minute halves will be played with a 2 minute halftime
- Goal size is approximately 3 feet high x 5 feet wide (Bownet Goals)
- Games are played with no keepers, following goal crease rule
- First Place and Second Place medals will be awarded in each division
- Shin guards must be worn
- Admission for spectators is free. Absolutely no carry-ins are allowed. Concessions will be available.

TOURNAMENT RULES

1. COACHES - Teams must check in 30 minutes before your first game and make sure your team understands the rules.
2. Players may run through the crease in front of the goal, but they are not allowed to touch the ball when they are in the crease. If defending team touches the ball in the crease a GOAL is awarded to attacking team. If attacking team touches the ball in the crease, NO GOAL. A direct kick is awarded to the defending team from that spot.
3. No slide tackling is allowed! Sliding is legal to stop a free moving ball, but it cannot be used to stop an opponent in possession of the ball.
4. An oncoming substitute cannot play the ball until his teammate is off the field. The penalty for illegal touching is an indirect kick from spot of violation.
5. All out of bounds will be restarted with a goal kick, corner kick, or an indirect kick. The ball must be close to stationary before it is put back into play.
6. The clock stops only for injury, obvious delay, or if a goal is scored in the last minute of the game.
7. The ball must completely cross the goal line for it to be a goal. It is the referees' decision.
8. Kick offs will be taken after an official blows his/her whistle. It is legal to pass the ball backwards on the kickoff.
9. If the ball stops dead in the crease, the restart is a goal kick for the defensive side.
10. Games will start on time. You can start with 2 players.
11. If a team is winning by 5 goals or more, the opposing team may add a player on the field until the score difference is less than 5 goals.
12. Parents, coaches, and players are expected to show good sportsmanship at all times. The tournament coordinator reserves the right to remove any one who displays poor sportsmanship. This includes, but not limited to, inappropriate language and aggressive tone.
13. WYSA and US Soccer policy & rules will apply to any situation not previously stated.

TOURNAMENT SCORING

Win	6 points
Draw	3 points
Loss	0 points
1 point per goal	Up to 6 points per game
Maximum points per game	12 points

Tie breaker order to determine top 2 teams playing in the Championship Game:

1. Head-to-Head result
2. Most wins in pool play
3. Fewest losses
4. Fewest goals allowed

Championship Game: Game will be played in (2) 12 minute halves with a 2 minute halftime. In the event of a tied score at the end of regulation, a 4 minute sudden death overtime will be played as 3v3. If at the end of the first overtime there is still a tie, a second 2 minute sudden death overtime will be played as 2v2. If at the end of the second overtime there is still a tie, a third sudden death overtime will be played 1v1.
