Call to order

A meeting of Prairie Storm Minor Hockey Association was held via Microsoft Team application on July 19, 2021 and was called to order at 6:35 PM by Lee Peters.

The highlights of the meeting were as follows:

- Lee Peters provided an update of the registration numbers as of the current date and there was a preliminary discussion around team numbers.
- Lee Peters provided the board with an update on the Female Association meeting and the Hockey Sask AGM.
- A player development committee has been formed and includes some of the board members. The committee has been reaching out to those within the community for guidance on the programs offered within Prairie Storm. An update was provided by the committee as to what is being discussed, which includes, but not limited to: Player evaluations, team sizes and development of players and coaches.
- The board motioned and approved to engage Hockey Sask for the upcoming evaluations for the 2021-2022 season.
- Prairie Storm will hold the U11 tournament in November this year. We do not have a tournament coordinator, so the Divisional Director will be reaching out to the membership for volunteers.
- Equipment and Inventory update was provided to the board. We are hoping to get Timbit jerseys for U7. Socks will also need to be ordered this year. Our equipment coordinator will

reach out to different vendors to inquire about pricing and will make a recommendation to the board.

- It has been confirmed that our application to host 2021-22 official clinic this year will take place October 10.
- The board discussed our ice contracts and are requesting that an “exit clause” be included in the contracts moving forward to help mitigate an event where the government mandates a shut down of hockey. This will be discussed amongst the board members and our facilities representatives.
- Ultimate Stride camp has requested that we advertise their camp and accept sponsorship in the form of a free registration. The board motioned and agreed to do so.
- Fall camps will be held again in the fall prior to evaluations. Our staff member will get the appropriate forms ready and this will be posted on our website and emailed out to the membership in August.
- The board is working on the SLGA grant applications
- The board will be sending out coach applications to the membership for sign up for the upcoming season. Those that require an updated vulnerable sector check will also be required to obtain this.
