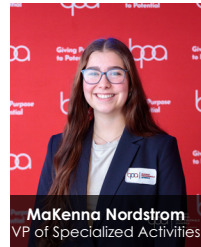
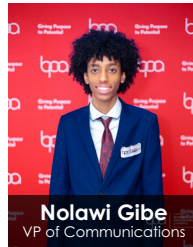
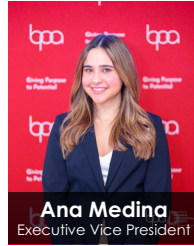

### ALL CONTESTS

- **PENS ARE REQUIRED FOR ALL CONTESTS.** "X" if changing answer.
- Use your identification number, not your name, on all contest materials.
- Previous editions of any Business Professionals of America test booklets are not allowed as reference materials at any testing site.
- Proper attire is required at all testing.
- Contest changes will be announced during the Advisor Meeting on Thursday, March 5, 2026.
- All contest conflicts must be reported in writing to the Grading Center by 11:30 a.m. on Thursday, March 5, 2026.
- The last exams for Opens/Generals will be given one hour prior to the end of the General Contest testing window. Testing will be available Thursday from 2:00 – 5:00 pm with completion at 6 pm and Friday from 9:00 am – 4:00 pm with completion at 5:00 pm.

### JUDGED CONTESTS

- If an event requires individual scheduling, schedules will be posted at Headquarters and/or printed on your "Personal Schedule" sheet. You can also scan the QR code on your name badge.

### CONTESTS USING EQUIPMENT

- You may not bring your own software or equipment to the computer lab.
- All testing will be held in the computer lab according to the schedule. Set up will be in a designated area of the lab.
- Only exception to bringing your own equipment is for programming events and Mac computers for Desktop Publishing.

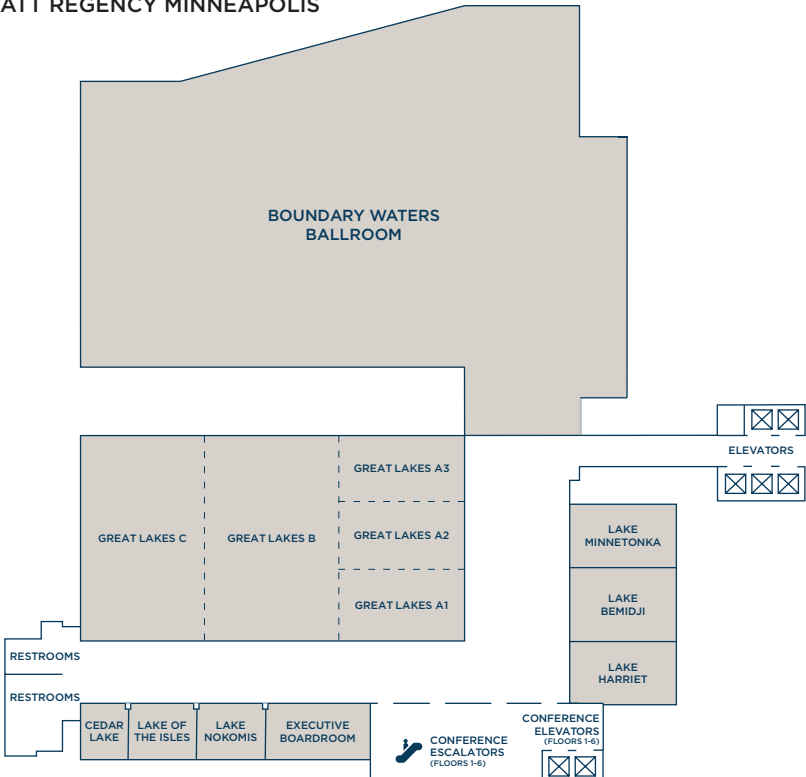
# FIFTH LEVEL

HYATT REGENCY MINNEAPOLIS

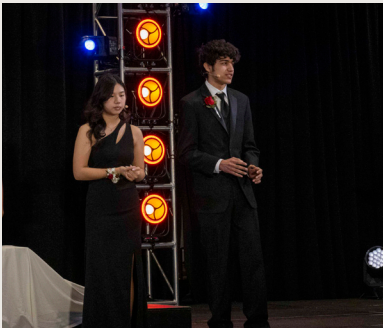
