### **TOURNAMENT RULES, REQUIREMENTS, ADMISSIONS FEES & VENUES**

- > Coaches check site at [WWW.FLFURY.COM](http://WWW.FLFURY.COM) on Wed., Thur. and Fri. nights for Schedule Changes/Updates
- \* Coaches should have Birth Certificates available in case Proof of Age is requested
- \* If you have not entered your Roster, access a PDF Roster Form on [WWW.FLFURY.COM](http://WWW.FLFURY.COM) and have it completed Prior to your Arrival. Coaches must submit any Deletions from Roster upon Arrival Sunday
- \* Coaches cannot add players to rosters on Sundays unless they are approved by Russ Gordner and Steve Polo or Scott Savage
- > 4<sup>th</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup> Grade: 20-minute Run clock halves; clock Runs on jump ball; Regulation clock last 1 min. each half; 14+ lead clock Runs last min.; No Press if up 20+ any time; 28.5/Sz 6 ball or o/wise agreed
- > 7<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> Grade: 16-minute Stop clock halves; No Press if up 20+ in 2<sup>nd</sup> Half, and Clock Runs; girls use 28.5/Sz 6 ball, boys use 29.5/Sz 7 ball
- > All games can start 20 minutes early; have your team ready!
- \* PLEASE TREAT OUR OFFICIALS WITH RESPECT! It's youth basketball, there are no scholarships.
- \* Note! Any Coach or Fan Verbal Abuse, Taunting, Physical Contact/Fighting, etc. May Result in Ejection, Game and/or Event Forfeiture
- \* Only 2 Coaches Allowed on Bench for All Games \* Only One Coach Allowed Standing During Games
- \* If Coach/Player Receives (2) Technical/Intentional Fouls in Tournament, They Sit Out Tournament
- \* Technical Fouls and Intentional Fouls: Fouled Team Awarded 2 Points, Plus the Ball
- > Two-shot free throws on 10th Foul in Half \* 5 Personal Fouls Per Player \* All Non-Shooting Fouls in Last 1 Minute of 2nd Half are 1&1, Unless the Team Is Already in the Two-Shot Bonus
- > Overtime is Sudden Death \* Championship Overtime is 2 Minutes with One Timeout Each \* If Still No Championship Winner, 1 Minute Overtime with No Timeouts...Then Sudden Death
- > Time Outs: 3 x 30-second time-outs to use at any time in game (allows for more floor coaching time)
- \* Teams Bring Their Own Score Book \* Home Team (1<sup>st</sup> Team Listed on Schedule) Coach or Parent Keeps Book \* Visitor Team (2<sup>nd</sup> Team Listed on Schedule) Parent Keeps Clock \* Keepers are neutral \* Home Team is Light Uni \* Visitor Team is Dark Uni \* Teams must clear their bench area of trash, etc. after game
- \* Maximum Roster Size for the Entire Event is 12 Players, unless approved by Bob Guy, Steve Polo, Scott Savage, Steve Sutfin, Jim DiSalvo or Russ Gordner \* No Roster Changes on Sundays
- > 3-Team Divisions: 2-Seed & 3-Seed Play Sunday with Winner Playing 1 Seed for Championship
- > 4-Team Divisions: Top Two Teams Play for Championship
- > 5-Team Divisions: Team with Best Overall Record wins Championship
- > Pool Play Divisions: Top Team in each Pool plays for Championship \* Crossover Games Do Not Count Toward Record (unless otherwise determined)
- > Tie-Breakers Are: Head To Head, then Points (Maximum +/- 15), then Coin Toss by Site Director \* forfeits result in +15 points (unless o/wise determined)
