Tee Ball Specific Rules and Information

To ensure each game goes smoothly, it is important to communicate some of the main rules to parents. If parents understand what to expect during the game, they can better prepare their child for the season. They will also be able to support the coaches and model good sportsmanship.

- Tee Ball Division plays by the Cal Ripken rules.
- Only Board approved Coaches are allowed on the playing field. Coaches can call parents onto the field at their discretion.
- Bases will be set up at 60' dimensions
- A Tee Ball game is 3 complete innings.
- No new inning after 1 hour 15 minutes. A new inning begins once the complete roster has batted.
- If a game is temporarily halted due to rain, lightning, or any other reason, the game clock will pause until the start of the next pitch.
- A game will be considered a regulation game if 3 innings have been completed.
- Home team will keep official time and notify coaches of time played at the conclusion of each inning.
- The complete roster shall bat each inning.
- Players playing the pitcher position must wear a batter's helmet.
- Coaches are required to play all players in the field and bat all players that attend each game.
- No runners will be called out; play will continue until entire roster bats.
- Runners advance station to station. There are no extra base hits, all hits are singles. The last player to bat will hit a home run.
- No leading off or stealing.

To develop players, it is necessary for players to attend practice on a regular basis.
