

KLSC Volunteer Awards

The purpose of the KLSC Volunteer awards is to recognize and honour outstanding individuals who are making a significant contribution to the club. Any member of the KLSC (Executive, Coach, Manager, Match Official, other volunteer) can be nominated.

Overall criteria to be considered by the Awards Committee members:

- impact/benefit to the membership of the club
- demonstrated dedication and commitment
- effective leadership

- length of volunteering
- demonstrated sportsmanship and dedication to soccer
- devoted, reliable and committed volunteer

Depending upon nominations received, the Awards Committee may select up to eight recipients each year for the following awards:

1. Volunteer Recognition Award

This award will be given to an individual who:

- demonstrates a love of the game
- enjoys working with players of all skill levels to help them develop to their full potential
- promotes fair play
- promotes sportsmanship
- is a role model for players, and their families
- the KSLC is proud to be represented by
- follows the rules and regulations of the game, ECOSA and OSA

2. Lifetime Service Award

This is awarded at the discretion of the President, if s/he feels that a person has made a significant contribution to the KLSC. This Award is to be presented to any KLSC Executive, Coach, Manager, Trainer or other volunteer that has provided 5 or more years of service, and it is felt they have gone above and beyond.

3. Inferno Spirit Award

An individual that demonstrates the spirit of soccer; the individual is dedicated to the sport of soccer and "eats, sleeps and breathes soccer".

4. Outstanding Contribution Award

An individual that made a valuable contribution to the KLSC in one particular year, and may not have 5 years of service with the KLSC.
