Preventing Sudden Cardiac Arrest in teens
and helping them Play Heart Smart

We have a great opportunity for our athletes to have a cardiac screening that will be done this summer by a group called Play Heart Smart. This is a cardiac screening that provides a blood pressure check, limited heart ultrasound, and an electrocardiogram (EKG). Cardiac screening is not something that is included in routine annual sports physicals. The goal of this is to check for congenital abnormalities of the heart that usually produce no symptoms, but can cause significant risk to our young athletes. Play Heart Smart is making it convenient to Impact by traveling to our location at RC on June 17th. The screening is very quick (10-12 min) and you will have results mailed to you within 1-2 weeks.
