

4v4G Division 1 Ontario Championship Day 2 Playoff Bracket Placement Explained

- Playoffs will be split into a Tier 1 bracket of 12, and a Tier 2 bracket of 8. Seeding for this Day 2 playoff brackets based on set ratio amongst teams with the same finish.
For example:
 - o The first-place teams from each pool will be the top 5 seeds for playoffs. They will be ranked 1-5 based on their set ratio, with point ratio as the tiebreaker if necessary. All five will be in the Tier 1 bracket, with the best four receiving first round byes to the Quarter Finals.
 - o The second-place teams from each pool will be the next 5 seeds for playoffs. They will be ranked 6-10 based on their set ratio, with point ratio as the tiebreaker if necessary. All five will be in the Tier 1 bracket.
 - o The third-place teams from each pool will be the next 5 seeds for playoffs. They will be ranked 11-15 based on their set ratio, with point ratio as the tiebreaker if necessary. The best two will be in the Tier 1 bracket, with the next three being in the Tier 2 bracket.
 - o The fourth-place teams from each pool will be the bottom 5 seeds for playoffs. They will be ranked 16-20 based on their set ratio, with point ratio as the tiebreaker if necessary. All five will be in the Tier 2 bracket.

- AES is currently displaying the playoff brackets as exact seeds based on pool finish (i.e 1st in Pool A is the #1 seed in Tier 1). As explained above, that is not necessarily the case. Since AES cannot do this automatically, OVA staff will manually be inputting the seeding upon the conclusion of pool play based on the ranking format above.
