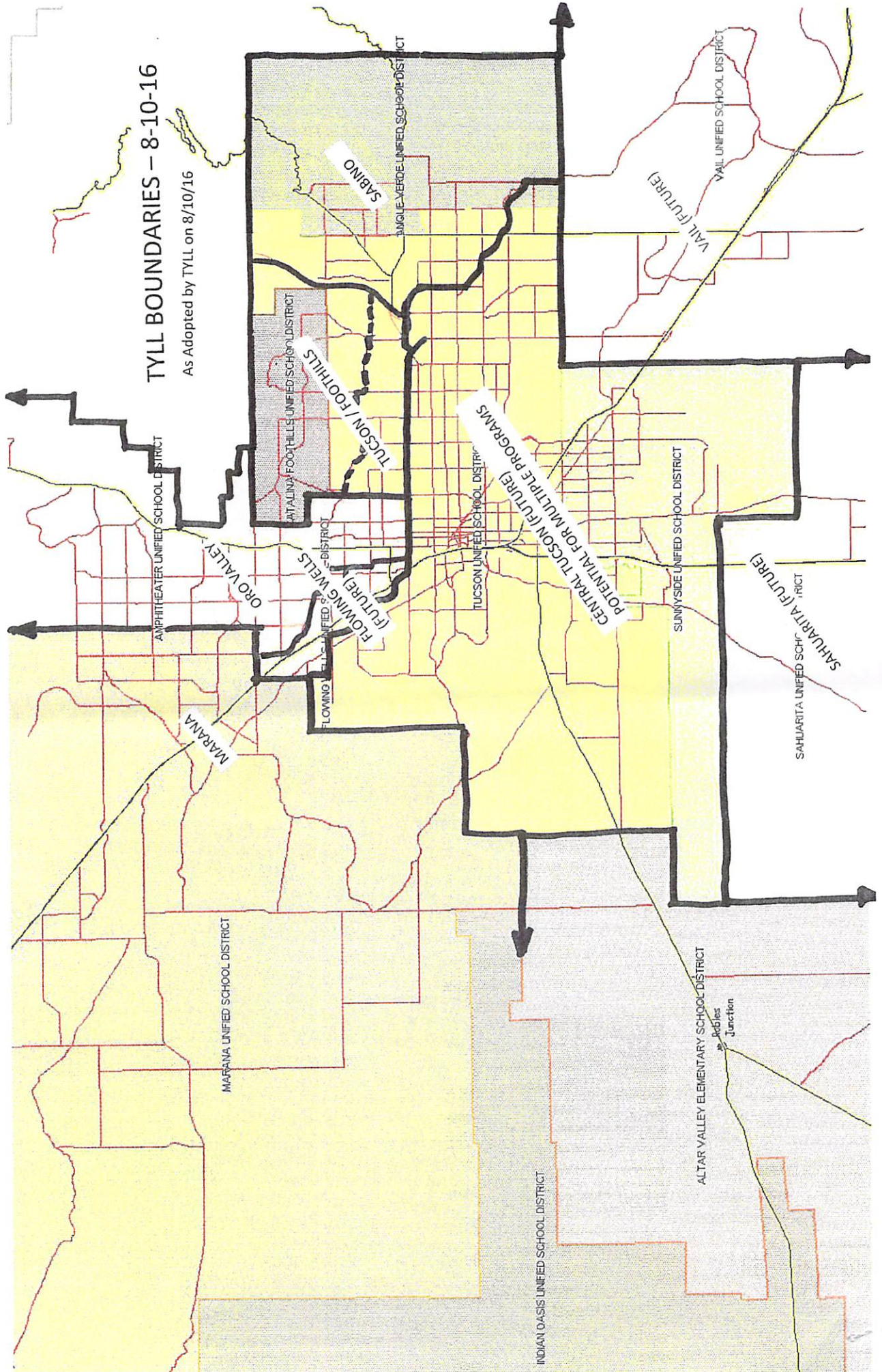


TYLL BOUNDARIES – 8-10-16

TYLL Boundary Descriptions (As Adopted by TYLL 8/10/16)

Program	Boundaries	2017 Season Status
Marana	Marana Unified School District including Red Rock in southern Pinal County	Boundary Standards apply
Oro Valley	Amphitheater School Districts and Oracle in southern Pinal County	Boundary Standards apply
Foothills / Tucson	<p>Catalina Foothill School District plus TUSD north of Grant Road, west of Sabino Creek, and north of Tanque Verde / Wrightstown Road</p> <p>Note: For future growth planning – If CF can support its own program in the future, the CF Boundary will be the CFSD Boundary – south to River Road / Cloud Road</p>	Boundary Standards apply
Sabino	Tanque Verde School District and portions of TUSD east of Bear Canyon, east of Harrison, and North of Old Spanish Trail	Boundary Standards apply if youth teams sponsored. Open recruiting if no youth teams sponsored.
Flowing Wells	Flowing Wells School District	Open Recruiting - Players encouraged to return to Flowing Wells when local program established
Vail	Vail School District	Open Recruiting - Players encouraged to return to Vail when local program established.
Sahuarita	Sahuarita School District	Open Recruiting – Players encouraged to return to Sahuarita when local program established.
Central Tucson	Other portions of TUSD and Sunnyside School District	Open Recruiting - Players encouraged to return to Central Tucson when local program established.

Standards for Application of Participation District Boundaries (As Adopted by TYLL 8/10/16)

- Participation Districts shall be coincidental with School District boundaries except as shown on the attached map.
- These standards shall apply to all schools within a Participation District including: public, private, parochial, and home schools.
- All students attending a school within a Participation District shall play for the home team or organization within that District, except:
 - If a family lives in one Participation District but has a child enrolled in a school within a different Participation District, the family can choose either District and their child may play for that District's team.
 - If a parent lives in one District but coaches in a different District, their child may play for the team / program the parent coaches.
 - If a child played for a team during the entire previous season, the player's family can elect to have their child continue to play for that team regardless of place of residence or location of school attended.
 - If a program does not field a team for a certain age group (K-3, U4, U6, JH as designated by TYLL and AYL) during a designated season then a child who would have played for the age group team within their home District may play for any participating TYLL program for that season only in which a program does not field a team.
- Players residing in a Participation District that currently does not have a program / team may be recruited by and play for any participating TYLL program.
- Once a player has completed a full year of participation with a team, that player may continue to play with that team until their pre-high school eligibility has expired.
- In a manner consistent with the goal of "growing the game," TYLL programs should encourage to players from outside of their Participation District to play for the new team within the player's Participation District, when a new team is established in that location.
- Requests for hardship or other waiver may be made to the TYLL Board of Directors or its designated subcommittee. Waivers will be granted only with the unanimous approval of the Board or Subcommittee.
- At the conclusion of the TYLL / AYL season, players may elect to play for any travel team or summer program.
