In 1971, a small group of parents banded together to form a softball league for their daughters and other girls in this valley. They named it "Bobby Sox". By 1974, with an increase in participation, the league grew and a more formalized league, the San Ramon Valley Girls Athletic League (SRVGAL), was organized. Since 1974, SRVGAL has been providing quality recreational softball to tens of thousands of girls between ages 5 and 18. Over 900 girls sign up to play annually, and today, SRVGAL is well regarded in national softball circles as the largest girls' softball league west of the Mississippi. The steady growth, success, and prosperity of SRVGAL could only be achieved through hundreds of women and men dedicating many volunteer hours of hard work. In 2001, the league established a Hall of Fame for those individuals who have spent many years on the board of directors and have given tirelessly of themselves. Umpire Recognition



Umpires are an integral part of running a successful softball season. They are impartial officials who ensure the rules of softball are enforced in every game. We do not use umpires in our PreK-K and 1/2 divisions as these divisions are intended to be an introduction to softball and scores are not kept. Once our players progress to the 3/4 white divisions and higher, umpires are utilized as the game becomes more structured, games are scored, and teams earn season rankings.

We have been fortunate to have several adult umpires who return every year. However, with the high volume of games our league organizes, SRVGAL relies heavily on the commitment of youth umpires to officiate many of these games. Our youth program is open to individuals turning 13 on April 1st of that year. They undergo rules and mechanics training annually and are provided with an official uniform. Umpires are assigned games based on their level of experience.

Many of our young umpires are also competitive softball athletes from our league, travel divisions, and local high schools. For many of them, umpiring is their first job and it provides them the opportunity to earn money while giving back to SRVGAL. It is also a great way for young people to learn how to become assertive, decisive, and vocal. They learn quickly how to deal with the stress of officiating a competitive game where emotions can run high from coaches, players, and spectators. They are instructed on how to behave professionally and level-headed in these situations.

As parents and coaches, we should do our best to encourage the participation and development of our young umpires by showing them respect and gratitude. Our goal should be to create an environment for the umpires to return for subsequent seasons which will directly influence the quality of officiating.
