# CPHL Fall Season - Games + Cost

- **Games**

- 10-15 regular season games per team
- Varsity - one, local preseason tournament
  - Preseason game vs. Cherry Creek on Sunday August 20th
- JV - two, local preseason tournaments
  - Preseason game vs. Cherry Creek on Friday August 18th
- **Total: 18-25 games per team**

- **Cost**

- \$100 Tryout Fee
  - \$500 deposit due by August 11th
    - Refunded to any player who does not make the team
  - \$2,400 Team Fees
  - At least first \$800 payment due by September 8th
  - **Total: \$2900**
  - Registration and online payment now open

# Lady Cats CPHL Season - Games + Cost

- **Games**

- **Total: 45-50 games**

- **Cost**

- \$100 Tryout Fee
  - \$500 deposit due by August 19th
    - Refunded to any player who does not make the team
  - \$3,500 Team Fees
  - At least first \$500 payment due by September 8th
  - **Total: \$4,000**
  - Registration and online payment now open

## CPHL Season - Fargo Force Fall Showcase

- **Invite-only showcase**
  - **Varsity T1 team will participate**
  - **Leaving on Thursday October 5th, 2023**
    - **Flight will be late morning/early afternoon**
  - **Returning Sunday October 8th, 2023**
    - **Flight leaves at 5pm CST**
  - **4 games against the top U18 AAA/Prep School teams in the country**
  - **Free attendance to a USHL Fargo Force game for all players and coaches**
  - **We will be assigned a hotel and each player's room and airfare are additional costs**
  - **Parents are welcome to attend**
  - **Ground Transportation for players will be provided**

## CPHL Season - Nashville Tournament

- **Varsity T2 (JV) team will participate**
  - **Big Bear Tournaments - Music City Showdown**
  - **Nashville area - Could play at 1 or more rinks**
  - **November 3rd - 5th**
  - **Players must check-in to hotel on Thursday**
  - **4 Game minimum - Games start early Friday and last game finishes no later than 5pm, Sunday**
  - **Game schedule released 7 days in advance**
  - **Stay to Play tournament - ALL PLAYERS MUST STAY IN OUR DESIGNATED HOTEL - 3 Night minimum stay required (Thur - Sat) - Additional Parent expense**

# CHSAA Season - Eligibility Guidelines

- Student athletes must be enrolled in 5 classes minimum
  - Ineligible if athlete has:
    - Two F's
    - Two D's and One F
  - Conduct
    - In addition to the DCSD rules and expectations for athletic participation, CV coaches reserve the right to enforce additional consequences on any athlete who does anything that detrimental to themselves or the team.

## Team Colorado

- Top 80 Colorado HS players are invited to attend the Team Colorado Evaluation Camp in March
  - The Top 40 players are selected to represent Colorado at one of two tournaments
    - Players 1 - 20: NIT in Minnesota in April
    - Players 21 - 40: America's Showcase in St. Louis, MO in April
  - Exposure to teams from every junior league, many NCAA and NHL teams
  - Last Season
    - CV was the second-most represented team at the Evaluation Camp
    - Five of our seven players at the Evaluation Camp were offered spots on Team Colorado
