## Policy on not being able to reschedule games

- 1. This policy will be used when there are games that must be rescheduled.
- 2. The use of the fields at Lear Park is controlled by the City of Longview. There are times when the fields are closed to everyone and games cannot be played. When this happens, only the following games will be rescheduled:
  - If a team notifies the office of going to a soccer tournament two weeks before their scheduled game as per our bylaws.
  - If a game is rained out.
  - If a game must be replayed because of an incomplete game, disaster, or misapplication of the Laws of the Game.
  - We will try to reschedule as many games as we are able to on our rainout day. League games will take priority over non-league games. Example: Game A is a non-league game that is rained out and then rescheduled to the rainout date. Game B is a league game that is rained out later in the same season, but cannot be rescheduled due to time constraints. Game B would then replace Game A on the rainout date.
- 3. Any standing game that cannot be rescheduled will be scored as a 3-3 tie and each team will receive six (6) points.
- 4. The following games will not be rescheduled:
  - Requests by out-of-town teams to re-schedule a game because they are unable to play the game.
  - Request to re-schedule a game because of an Academy Tournament. (NTSSA rule 3.10.3.9)
