



Milwaukee Winter Club-University School of Milwaukee Uihlein Ice Arena Covid-19 Protocols

The Milwaukee Winter Club in partnership with the University School of Milwaukee has established the following protocols for Return to Play in the Uihlein Ice Arena. These rules are effective until further notice from 11/01/2020. You can view our full policy at winterclub.com.

Masks MUST always be worn while in the arena. This includes during on ice play for players, coaches, and referees. No spectators will be allowed into the arena.

Prior to arrival at the rink and the day of your game scan this code and complete the Covid-19 Questionnaire. You will need to take your child's temperature. A screen shot of the form completion will be required to enter the rink. Temperatures will also be taken prior to entering the arena. Doing this ahead of time will speed the entry process.



1. All persons must always wear a facial covering over the nose and mouth within the arena, including while on the ice.
2. Bubble masks (holes on bottom must be covered with the coagulate shield) and the CCM cage mask are approved.
3. Players must enter the arena fully dressed with the exception of Skates, Helmets and Gloves. Goalies may fully dress, but there is to be no use of restrooms for dressing. Locker rooms are not available currently for use. Parents of squirts and under will be permitted into the arena to tie skates, but then must immediately leave. Pee wee and above parents will not be permitted into the arena. Coaches will need to tie skates for those players that still need it.
4. Do not enter the arena until 15 minutes prior to the start of your ice time. You will be asked to wait outside until then and while cleaning is completed from prior use.
5. Players will be directed to either the bleachers and or the lobby to put on skates, helmets, and gloves. There is seating that is marked and spaced 6' apart for distancing. Do not move chairs from their spots.
6. All players must supply their own water bottles. Bottle fillers are available to fill them in the arena if needed.
7. At the end of play, players are to only remove, Skates, Helmets and Gloves and immediately exit the arena through the North West door exiting near the tennis courts. Follow the signage.
8. If your child or any family member is sick, please stay away from the rink and stay home.
9. Our rink is supported by LiveBarn, search for Uihlein Ice Arena and you can watch the game.
