This COVID-19 “Game Protocol” plan will follow the instructions of officials from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, Washington State and local public health departments to prevent the spread of COVID-19. This will document will be updated as requirements change.

### Things to remember for parents

THERE WILL BE A ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY FOR PLAYERS/PARENTS NOT FOLLOWING THE GUIDELINES IN THIS DOCUMENT.

All athletes, coaches, volunteers, officials, spectators, and other personnel are required to stay at home if feeling sick or experiencing COVID-19 symptoms. Any player reporting or demonstrating symptoms of illness at any point will be removed from the game.

All athletes, coaches, volunteers, officials, spectators, and other personnel are required to wear masks at all times.

All wellness forms / attestations must be complete before entering the game field (see below for details).

It is the parent’s responsibility to review the guidance of this document with their players.

### Prior to the Game

#### COVID-19 Attestation

- North Tapps Legacy Lacrosse parents or players must complete the online wellness form prior to attending games. Players will not be allowed on the field until the health check is complete.
- Visiting Teams must fill out their team wellness form prior to attending games. If the team does not have an online wellness / attestation form, they must use the NTLLC online wellness form. If you need access to the wellness form, please contact Beth Spencer@(206) 380-5994
- Team Managers or Coaches should ensure that wellness screens are complete for all players on each team. No player or coach should enter the field without the health check complete.
- **Coaches are required to sign a COVID-19 Team Wellness Form at the table BEFORE WARMUPS attesting that their team wellness forms / attestations are complete, and no players or coach has**

## NTLLC COVID-19 Game Protocol

COVID-19 symptoms or has been exposed to COVID-19. This form will be kept for a minimum of 30 days and will be used for contact tracing as needed. If contact tracing is needed, the Coach or Team Manger on the opposing team will be contacted to assist in the contact tracing effort.

### Entering the field

- All players, parents, and coaches should not enter their designated field until the previous group has exited.
- Players must wear masks at all times, entering the field, during game play\*, on the sidelines and exiting the field.
  - *\*In Phase 3 players are not required to wear masks during game play, but the NTLLC players will be encouraged wear helmet masks for ease of compliance.*
- Players must maintain socially distanced, including on the sidelines
- Coaches, volunteers and officials must wear masks at all times

### Spectators

- To adhere to Phase 2 requirements, Spectators will be limited to 3 per family.
- Spectators must wear masks at all times
- Spectators must remain socially distanced and adhere to the COVID-19 spectator requirements <https://www.governor.wa.gov/sites/default/files/COVID19%20Spectator%20Event%20Guidance.pdf>

### Game Table Setup

- Game Tables must be set up to allow volunteers to be 6' apart
- Hand sanitizer & disinfectant spray must be available on the game table
- Coaches must complete the team attestation at the game table prior to beginning warmup

### During Game Play

- During half time or when players are not in the game, players must remain socially distanced.
  - Benches should not be used.
  - Players should bring their own water and they should not be shared with any other player.
  - Players must wear face coverings while not in the game. It is recommended that players keep their helmets on at all time with the helmet mask attached. If a player needs to remove their helmet, a face mask must be worn.
- In the event of injury, staff may assist in the management of proper first aid. Family members may participate in injury management if necessary. Players should maintain a social distance.

### Post-Game

- No handshakes or high-fives after the game.
- Teams must exit the field immediately after the game has ended.
- Honor the Game will be done independently, each coach will award their own player stickers.
