Misco Twins- "Sahee, we think the Farca's have a great team. We think they're going to score the most touchdowns."

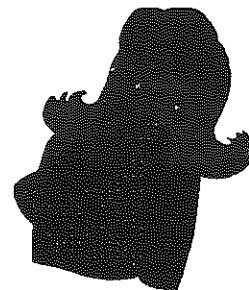
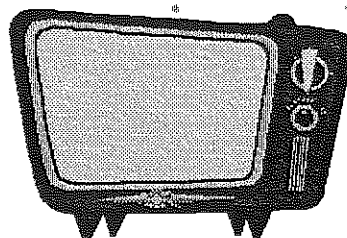
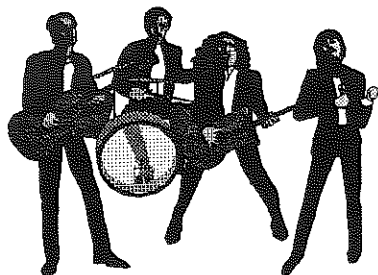

YMSL RULES AND REGULATIONS:

- 1- EVERY PLAYER MUST BE PAID IN FULL BY OPENING DAY- \$160.00. NO PARTIAL PAYMENTS WILL BE ACCEPTED.
- 2- PINCH RUNNER RULE A: EACH TEAM WILL BE ALLOWED FOUR PINCH RUNNER PER GAME. THE PINCH RUNNER MUST BE THE PLAYER THAT MADE THE LAST ACTUAL OUT (NO FIELDER'S CHOICE OR FORCE OUTS) B: IF A TEAM CHOOSES TO GO OVER THE ALLOTMENT OF RUNNERS, THE OPPOSING TEAM PICKS ITS CHOICE OF RUNNER, UNLESS HE'S ON DECK. C: SLOTTED PLAYERS DO NOT COUNT AS PINCH RUNNERS. EITHER THE HITTER OR SLOTTED PLAYER MAY RUN.
- 3- SLOTTED PLAYERS MAY NOT BE IN MORE THAN 1 SPOT IN THE ORDER
- 4- SUBSTITUTES- THERE ARE NO SUBSTITUTES UNLESS THE PLAYER IS OUT FOR THE YEAR. A: SUBSTITUTES FOR PITCHERS- ONLY IF THE PITCHER IS GOING TO MISS A MINIMUM OF 2 WEEKS.
- 5- TRADING DEADLINE- BEFORE THE START OF THE FIFTH WEEK
- 6- NO JEANS (EXCEPTION FOR RED)
- 7- NO METAL CLEATS
- 8- SLIDING RULE- PLAYERS MUST SLIDE ON ALL CLOSE PLAYS. IT IS THE UMPIRE'S DECISION WHETHER THE BASEMAN WAS BLOCKING THE RUNNER'S BASE-PATH WITHOUT THE BALL. ABSOLUTELY NO BARRELING INTO FIELDERS.
- 9- NO TEAM CAN START A GAME WITHOUT AT LEAST 9 PLAYERS.
- 10- RUNNERS CAN NOT LEAD UNTIL AFTER THE BALL CROSSES THE PLATE.
