EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

- Playoffs almost over, going well and want to thank all of our hosts.
- Academic All Stars deadlines can come in late and we will still be accepted.
- PAHL Scholarship application reminders went out. Deadline is March 20. We would like to have them for the April meeting.
- Referee Mentor forms went out today.
- Rule changes will be handled at the April 19th meeting and if you have anything else you would like to discuss please email me.

COMPETITION

- Cleaning up things to get ready for next season.
- Need to find a technology solution and data management for what has been done manually for the upcoming 23/24 season and start getting bids. Working through setting up some meeting now.

DISCIPLINE

OLD BUSINESS

- Bylaw changes:
 - Notification of meetings section changed to what we actually do. The statement about quarterly meetings and the virtual meeting have been changed. We do not need to specify the difference in our bylaws. Whether we meet in person or have a virtual meeting, both will still count as our quarterly meeting.
 - Executive Officer's titles changed to more of a generic title, back to 1st Vice President, 2nd VP, etc. Going forward we will not have to change titles; we will just have to amend the VP's duties specifically attaching those positions to functions. As time moves forward if one of those vice-presidents should be handling something different, we won't have to go through a whole bylaw change.
