## RULES

1. Travesty Rule – In all games played; the **20 run rule** is in effect after the Third inning, **15 run rule** after the fourth inning and **10 run rule** after 5 inning. **Run spot** does not count towards the travesty rule.
2. Teams must have a minimum of **9 players** for all tournament games. Teams are allowed three **pick-up players**. Pickup players must be from the same or lower classification, within the same division (Men's). **Pickup players MUST** wear a jersey that is different than the team jerseys of the team they are picking up with. ***All pick-up players must be reported to the Anchorage Sports office (toner@anchoragesports.com) by 5:00pm on Wednesday, May 14th.*** This will allow coaches time to view rosters and vote on the **tier list**.
3. Teams must have similar uniforms with a minimum of a six (6) inch number on the back.
4. Batting orders are to be submitted to the official scorekeeper at least 5 minutes before game time.
5. Before the game, a coin toss will determine the home team. Undefeated team will be the home team for Final. In the event there is an 'if' game, the home team will be decided by a coin flip.
6. "Low-Bid" home run rule will be determined before coin toss. Minimum bid will be the "C" league home run rule of two (2) up. There is no maximum bid.
7. Game time is forfeit time. No grace period is permitted unless the scheduled team(s) are still participating in an earlier tournament game. All games will have a 55-minute time limit, except the championship and "if" game which will have no time limit.
8. The International Tie-breaker rule will be used for any games ending in a tie during regulation play.
9. The tournament director will provide one new ball for each game. If a team hits a homerun, they must retrieve the ball or provide an official USA 52/300 replacement ball.
10. The protest committee will consist of the Tournament Director, a Senior Official, and a third person of the Tournament Director's choosing.
11. Infield practice is not allowed.
12. **Shelled nuts and glass containers are not allowed at the Jean Cartee Softball Complex.**
13. **Pets are not allowed at the Cartee Softball Complex with the exception of registered service animals.**
14. Anchorage Sports and USA Softball of Alaska rules will be used except where stated within this profile.
15. No entry fee refunds will be made unless the entire tournament is rained out.
