



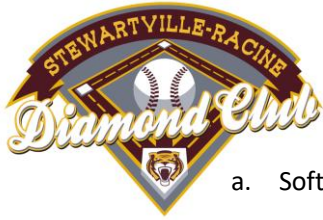

1. Call to Order – Tony calls to order at 6:07 pm.
2. Approve minutes from the 3/12/25 regular meeting (no paper copies provided) – Luke makes a motion to approve, Carmen seconds. Motion carried.
3. Entertain changes to the agenda – None for tonight.
4. Treasurer Report – Tony Lehrman (for Brandon)
 - a. Bank Accounts – approximately \$133,000
 - b. Income/Expenses – March \$8K net loss, March YTD net income of \$19.5K... Tony makes a motion to approve, Carmen makes a motion, Luke seconded.
5. Salt Sales Update - Brenda Hebl
 - a. 3,011 bags sold in 2025 which was more than last year. Profit margin was lower than last year due to the cost of the salt at \$5.75. \$9,500 for profit on this approximately. Dan Horstman is willing to use his forklift for those that ordered pallets.
6. Concessions Update - Brenda Hebl
 - a. The water is not on yet. Unlikely the concessions are open for the game this Saturday. Brenda is preparing to open as soon as possible.
 - b. Brenda sent out a notice to 7th and 8th grade baseball and softball parents to see if they can close down the concessions. It would only be on nights that there kid plays down there.
7. 2025 MN Twins Game & High School Game Update - Tyler Schmitz
 - a. Approximately 900 tickets sold at \$20 per ticket. Financials in March are not reflective of the actual sales that have been completed.
 - b. Bus for Twins game - (Brenda/Tyler)
 - i. Brenda contacted Grism and it's \$675 for the bus to the Twins game and the Twins website states \$30 per bus for parking. Potential cap the bus seating to 45 people at \$15 per passenger. Grism would allow us to tentatively reserve it. We need someone to check bus riders off the list for the who enters the bus. We would give that individual a free seat to the twins and the bus.
8. Facilities
 - a. Field Maintenance Planning/Batting Cage/Safety Updates – Mark Schmitz
 - i. Mark – forwarded the quote to Tony from Beacon which was lower than last year. The quote is for the whole thing (material), we already have a quote from Benike for installation.
 - ii. Materials for just the batting cage is \$15K (double cage).
 - iii. Mark, Jeremy, Jason, et al, needs to come together to decide batting cage option before May.
 - iv. We will hold a meeting before May to consider approval of purchasing and moving forward. We will announce the meeting for the public to attend when we know the date.
 - v. Mark brought forward a sample program for the baseball team and softball team if they so choose to make them for their respective varsity teams.
