



Our USA Hockey and PNAHA Screening Policy requires the following people to complete the requirements listed below:

1. Program administrators, including Board Members, Hockey Directors and other program staff who have regular access to or supervision over minor participants.
2. Coaches
3. Team Managers
4. Officials
5. Locker Room Monitors
6. Team Drivers (unless professional transportation companies are used)
7. Travel Chaperones
8. Everyone with Regular Access to Youth Participants

## **PROGRAM ADMINISTRATORS, BOARD MEMBERS, HOCKEY DIRECTORS, PROGRAM STAFF, TEAM MANAGERS, LOCKER ROOM MONITORS, EVERYONE WITH REGULAR ACCESS TO YOUTH PARTICIPANTS**

- Register as a volunteer with USA Hockey - [usahockeyregistration.com](http://usahockeyregistration.com) (free).
- Complete a background check with PNAHA at [pnaha.com](http://pnaha.com) (valid for 2 years).
- Complete the SafeSport Training course [usahockey.com/safesporttraining](http://usahockey.com/safesporttraining) (free). The SafeSport Training and Refresher Training are each valid for one (1) season beginning on 4/1/19. Please Note: if you took the training during the 2018-19 season, it is still valid for the 2018-19 and 2019-20 seasons.
- Forward your USA Hockey number and background check to your Association Registrar.

## **ALL HEAD AND ASSISTANT COACHES 18 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER**

- Register as a coach with USA Hockey - [usahockeyregistration.com](http://usahockeyregistration.com).
- Complete a background check with PNAHA at [pnaha.com](http://pnaha.com) (valid for 2 years).
- Complete the SafeSport Training course [usahockey.com/safesporttraining](http://usahockey.com/safesporttraining) (free). The SafeSport Training and Refresher Training are each valid for one (1) season beginning on 4/1/19. Please Note: if you took the training during the 2018-19 season, it is still valid for the 2018-19 and 2019-20 seasons.

## **TO COMPLY WITH THE LAW REQUIRING ADULTS WITH REGULAR CONTACT TO COMPLETE TRAINING, USA HOCKEY MUST REQUIRE THAT (I) ALL PLAYERS 17 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 31 OF THAT PLAYING SEASON AND (II) WHO PLAY ON A TEAM IN A CLASSIFICATION THAT ALLOWS MINOR AGE PLAYERS, COMPLETE SAFESPORT TRAINING BEFORE BEING ADDED TO SUCH TEAM AND PRIOR TO PARTICIPATION (ON-ICE OR OFF-ICE).**

- Using your current USA Hockey number, complete the SafeSport Training course [usahockey.com/safesporttraining](http://usahockey.com/safesporttraining) (free). The SafeSport Training and Refresher Training are each valid for one (1) season beginning on 4/1/19.

## **REGISTRARS AND PROGRAM ADMINISTRATORS**

- Registrars: Your program must claim all persons listed above in your program registry so that you can verify that all persons required to complete training have done so.
- Programs should review their internal lists of persons with regular contact with or authority over minors, and confirm that all such persons have registered with USA Hockey, been claimed by the program, and have completed SafeSport Training and the required background check.
