



Midwest League Travel championship 2021-2022

The Midwest hockey league is excited to announce details for play during the upcoming 21-22 season. Leaders have been planning tirelessly over the summer to create a model which we feel allows freedom and flexibility across the affiliate while at the same time provides structure and a true end of season championship for each division. All teams who register will be required to play 12 “regular season” games against a minimum of 4 different opponents from the pool of teams registered. All teams will then be seeded into divisions for the championship weekend planned in Des Moines, IA-Mar 11-13, 2022.

Please note important dates and details below:

Aug 20-Oct 15, 2021

- Registration available for MWAHA travel teams at www.tristatehockey.com , all teams who plan to participate in the regular season and year end event need to register and submit a non-refundable \$500 down payment. A portion of that down payment will be applied to the finals entry fee which we estimate will be \$1,000-\$1,200 per team/division.

Oct 16-31, 2021

- Team Managers and coaches will receive contact information from other member teams and take part in a ZOOM call with our MHL scheduler to set up their 12 regular season games (Ideally a mix of home and away sets) which then must be submitted to the MHL. If you have already set up games before the Nov 1 start date that is fine, games can be counted retroactive if both teams agreed those will be counted as regular season games.

Nov 1, 2021-Feb 20, 2022

- Midwest hockey league regular season play occurs, each scoresheet will need to be submitted to our league statistician with results and standing being kept in real time available on the MHL webpage. Team managers will be given access and be required to enter their own game schedule and post their own scores.

Feb 21-Feb 27, 2022

- The Midwest hockey league committee will create a scoring matrix based on regular season results that seeds teams into two divisions for our year end tournament: Gold and Silver (Bronze if applicable)

Mar 11-13, 2022

- Midwest league travel championship-Des Moines, IA
