MATCHDAY PREVIEW

RENO RETURNS HOME TO TAKE ON SACRAMENTO REPUBLIC FC



RENO, Nev. – Fresh off of a 2-1 road comeback win on Wednesday, Reno 1868 FC returns home to take on Sacramento Republic FC on Saturday. Reno enters the match sporting a record of 7-4-5 with 26 points, good for fourth in the USL's Western Conference. Sacramento comes to town with a 7-5-2 record, and their 23 points have them in seventh place.

On Wednesday, Reno picked up three big points with a comeback win in Portland. Portland Timbers 2 entered in second place in the conference, and lead 1-0 at halftime. Danny Musovski and Seth Casiple would score in the 60th and 62nd minutes, respectively, to secure the win for Reno.

Sacramento is coming off of a dominant 6-0 home win against Tulsa. Cameron Iwasa and Stefano Bonomo each had a pair of goals in the win.

Reno won the first Donner Pass Derby match of the season, winning on the road 4-1 in May. 1868 FC owns a 3-1-1 all-time record against Sacramento in USL Championship play.

The match gets underway at 7:15 p.m. PT, and will be streamed on ESPN+. The first 1,000 fans in attendance will also receive a free t-shirt, and tickets are still available at reno1868fc.com, or the Greater Nevada Field ticket office.

#2 EMRAH KLIMENTA (D)

HEIGHT: 5'11"

Klimenta, 28, signed with Reno 1868 FC early into the 2019 season. The defender joins Reno after a lengthy career with Sacramento Republic FC. Klimenta became Republic FC's all-time leader in minutes, appearances, and starts for the club. The defender had 102 total appearances, nine goals and five assists.

Richards, 28, a returning defender for Reno 1868 FC boasted 122 clearances, 16 blocks, and 73 interceptions in the 2018 season. He added to a stellar defensive season with four assists and a 73 percent pass success rate in 33 games.

#18 JT MARCINKOWSKI (GK)

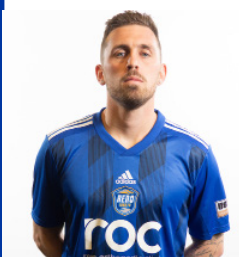

Russell played for the University of Washington and later started his professional career with the Seattle Sounders of the USL First Division in 1998 and 1999. Russell was drafted by the San Jose Earthquakes in 2000 and continued to play seven seasons in MLS. Six of those seasons came with the Earthquakes, where Russell helped the team win two MLS Cups in 2001 and 2003. In 2008, Russell returned to the Earthquakes as an assistant coach, a position he held for eight seasons. He helped lead the club to the postseason twice, while earning the Supporters' Shield for best regular season record (19-6-9) in 2012. Russell was also instrumental in the Quakes' international and collegiate scouting efforts, and briefly helped oversee the club's youth development as the academy's technical director. He served as the Earthquakes interim head coach for the final two games of the 2014 season and holds a U.S. Soccer Federation "A" coaching license.

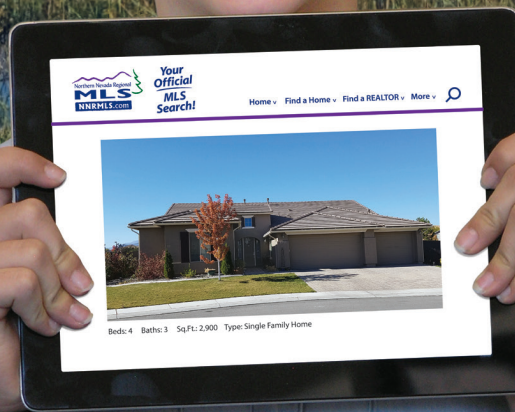
