

Standings & Playoff Regulations

1) Two points will be given to the winning team. If the teams remain tied after overtime, each team will be awarded one point. If a team does score, the winning team will be awarded two points and the losing team will receive one point. In the event that overtime cannot be played due to time constraints the game will be declared a tie and each team will receive one point. In the event of both teams forfeiting, they both receive one point and the game is recorded as a tie. If only one team forfeits, the non forfeiting team receives two points.

2) Team Standings will be decided by Points. Unless teams finish the year having played unequal games, in which case Highest Points Percentage will be the deciding factor. If tied in Points or Points Percentage (in uneven games played situation) the tie will be broken in the following order:

- Most Wins
- Head-to-head records between the tied teams
- Fewest goals against

3) Playoff matchups will be determined as follows, depending on the number of teams in the League for that season:

(Note: Home team will be team that finished higher in regular season standings. The third place game will played after game 1 of finals.)

4) Players have to play six regular season games to be eligible for the wildcard, semifinals and finals. There is no minimum amount of regular season games required to play in the third place game. There is no difference in minimum games played based on date of registration. Players can still play in all regular season games regardless of number of games played. (Note: If a team plays less than fifteen games, the minimum games played requirement will change based on the number of games played. 14 games played – 5 games played minimum, 13 games played – 4 games played minimum, etc. If a team plays more than fifteen games, the minimum games played requirement will still be 6 games played.)
