Huron Valley VBC Tournaments

LOCATION: Huron Valley Sports Center, 815 Woodland Drive, Saline, MI, 48176

TIME: Gym opens at 8:15 am. Coaches meeting at 8:30. **Play will start promptly at 9 am.** Late teams will forfeit their match. Check in with the site manager when you arrive. Coaches must leave your AAU-generated rosters with the site manager. Teams must have correct paperwork to compete!

CONCESSIONS / COOLERS: **NO Concessions available.** Teams may bring in coolers & team tables. Keep all food & coolers in the "Camping" space – none in the court area. No crock pots or other electrical appliances allowed. **All teams must clean up their area before leaving.**

ADMISSION CHARGE: \$5 per adult and \$2 for students. **Players & kids ages 10 & under are free.** We do have WiFi! 😊 (hvvc_815 is the password)

SEATING: Spectators must bring their own chairs. Do not put chairs behind the endline on Court 1.

PARKING-- please park on WEST side of building. Only use the front driveway for dropping off. IF the west side becomes full, additional parking is BEHIND the bowling alley across the street.

WARM-UPS: **WARM UP & GAME BALLS ARE PROVIDED – teams should not bring any balls.** 10 minutes prior to each team's first match only – 2 minutes shared ball handling; 4 minutes full court for each team including serving. Serving team has the first 4 minutes. NO SHARED HITTING OR SERVING. After first matches, warm-ups consist of TWO minutes on court, **no balls.** No warming up with balls off court (there is no space for this).

OFFICIALS: **NO REFS PROVIDED.** All teams officiate, score, and line judge. Please be on time and ready to officiate your assigned matches. **NO ELECTRONICS ON THE WORK TEAMS!**

For all ages, a trained player may be the R1 during pool play only, as long as they are directly supervised on the court by their coach. **All playoff matches must have an adult as R1!!** All teams must know how to use the USAV scoresheet including using "exit scores". (this is NOT the same as the high school score sheet). Please have a coach supervise the score table if your players are inexperienced scorekeepers. Spectators may not approach the court or score table with questions about the score or officiating!

TOURNAMENT FORMAT:

4 teams per pool maximum per court. Pool play will usually consist of two games to 25 points (cap of 27 in pool play only). All teams advance to playoffs. Playoff seeding & info will be handed out at the Coach's meeting. Playoff matches will be best 2 out of 3 with no cap, deciding games are 15 points. Seeding will be determined by overall record in pool play. Tie breakers: 1) Head to head games, 2) Head to head points, 3) Overall point differential, 4) Coin flip. **NOTE: To finish by 5 pm, playoff matches that begin at 4 pm or later MAY be shortened to play 18 point sets (start at 7-7).**

RULE REMINDERS: USA Volleyball rules apply, including:

- **ALL CURRENT USAV RULES USED - INCLUDING NET & CENTERLINE!** Coaches must know!
- 12s-14 players allowed an extra toss per serve (every other serve). 15s & up do not receive a 2nd serve toss.
- 12's competitions use the Volley-Lite ball. (12s teams playing "up" in 13/14s will use a regulation ball).
