



Appleton Family Ice Center and Tri-County Ice Arena Coaches, Participants and Spectators Responsibilities

- Following CDC Guidelines- Players, Coaches or Spectators shall not enter AFIC or TCIA if they have any of the following symptoms:
 - Cough
 - Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
 - Fever or Chills
 - Muscle pain or sore throat
 - New loss of taste or smell
 - Vomiting
 - Exposure to anyone known to test positive to COVID in last 14 days
- **It doesn't matter how far you have driven or flown into Appleton to play in or watch games; you will be asked to leave the building if you are not following the rules.**

Players and Coaches Responsibilities

- Entrance to the building is 15 minutes before your posted skate time. As Example-- If your team skates at 2:00pm, you should not be in the facility before 1:45pm!
- Facial coverings must be worn at all times in the building, including while on the ice for practices and games. There are no medical exemptions to this rule at this time.

- Upon Entering the Building- head directly to your assigned locker room. **You will only have 10 minutes to get ready to take the ice. 5 minutes to exit the locker room.** Come dressed minus skates, leave dressed minus skates.
- **No hockey bags or duffle bags of any kind are permitted in the facility.** (Except goalies)
- No team warm-ups in the common areas of the facility.
- Lockers Rooms will only be available for 10 minutes before the games and for teams to convene between periods should an ice resurface be needed.
- There is no dressing or undressing anywhere in the facility. Leave the arena dressed, minus skates, after completion of play.
- **No locker rooms will be available for practices.** Use the dressing area off the lobby at both TCIA and AFIC

Spectator Responsibilities

- Facial coverings must be worn at all times in the building. There are no medical exemptions to this rule at this time.
- Door will be open from posted game time to 15 minutes thereafter. Any spectators missing the entry window will not be allowed into the facility.
- Do not enter the building until your posted game time. If you play at 2:00pm, that gives you the 5-minute warm-up period to enter the rink and find a seat.
- Leave immediately after completion of play. No congregating in the lobby or common areas of the rink.
- Social Distance in the stands. 6 feet of separation except for immediate family.
- **Spectators are for games only. There are NO spectators for practice.**
